

Middle School After School Program (A.P.) Policies 2022-2023

A.P. is a supervised study hall for Middle School students.

A.P. runs Monday through Friday from dismissal until 5:30 p.m., free of charge. Late pick-ups will be charged \$1/minute per child charged in \$15 increments via Smart Tuition.

Students in extracurricular activities that end later than 5:15 p.m. will wait with their advisor or coach for parent pick up.

Students must report to A.P. immediately following dismissal or the conclusion of athletics, clubs, music lessons, or tutoring. Students are not permitted to leave campus and return to A.P. under any circumstance. Students may not “hang out” or be supervised by older siblings while on campus without a parent or guardian.

Students may not use Lyft, Uber, or other rideshare services unless upon proper written agreement with the MS Division Head and Extended Day Director.

While at A.P., students may socialize with peers or use their devices. When possible, the A.P. proctor may take students outside or to on campus events.

A.P. has a phone number that you can call if you need to get in contact with your student or to notify the proctor you have arrived for pick up: 617-865-5338. If you are unable to reach the A.P. proctor by phone, please contact Claire Harrison, Director of Extended Day at 617-278-2301.

If a student violates any of these policies or the Brimmer student conduct policies, they will receive a warning. After the second instance, the Director of Extended Day will contact the student’s guardian to arrange immediate pickup. If there are subsequent infractions, the student may not be permitted to attend A.P. for a longer period.
