Driving Directions - The Ballibay Camps

Take the best route to Scranton.
There is a Superhighway from all
Metro areas to Scranton.

Exit I-81 at No. 194, Clarks Summit
and take the exit North & West
marked "Towanda, RT 6 & 11." In
about 10 minutes Rt 6 & 11 split.
Bear to the right to stay on Rt 6
West. You will pass through the
towns of Tunkhannock, Meshoppen,
Laceyville and in about 30 minutes
you will pass through Wyalusing.
You'll see signs for Camptown, but
don't make any turns. Stay on RT 6
and in about 5 miles you will come
to Rt 409.

Turn right onto Rt 409 and continue
approx. 2 miles to Comiskey Rd/
Township Road 612, turning left
onto Comiskey. Comiskey Road is
at the end of a leftward, downhill
curve and come up fast. Be sure to
slow down approaching the turn!

Drive one half mile on Comiskey
to a Y intersection, turning left
onto Ballibay Road. Proceed three
quarters of a mile to The Ballibay
Camps. The main office will be on
your left.
