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Costume, Make-Up and Hair Instructions

Costume Instructions

- All female dancers should wear a spaghetti strap/nude-colored leotard under the costumes to facilitate fast changes. This leotard can be bought at any dancewear store.
- Please have your dancer bring a bathrobe, or other appropriate cover-up, for use during make-up application and eating snacks.
- Ballet dancers are to wear pink convertible tights and pointe shoes.
- Modern dancers are to wear no tights and no shoes. Skin-colored or tan foot undies may be worn.
- Every dancer is responsible for their costume(s) during the rehearsal and production time. If any costume becomes damaged, the cost of repairs or replacement will be the student's responsibility.
- Your Middle and Upper School Ambassadors organize costumes for the production. If you are a
 parent who is interested in helping the Ambassadors with costume organization, please contact
 Dawn Loring, Dance Program Office Manager, at dloring@smhall.org. Dancers should inform their
 Ambassador or Ms. Loring of any problem with costumes immediately.

Makeup Instructions

All dancers (except lead characters listed below) should follow the same instructions:

- Soft pink eye shadow
- White eye shadow
- Blush
- Translucent powder
- High pigmentation lipstick-light pink combined with red.
- Fake eyelashes encouraged
- Black eye liner
- Mascara

- Additional SMH staff, parent chaperones, and volunteers will assist in dressing rooms at all times.
- Costumes may not be removed from the dressing rooms during production week.

- Sunday, April 7. Warm up 12:30 pm to 1:00 pm onstage. Show: 2:00pm.
- Light snacks will be organized by parent volunteers. Additional SMH staff and parent chaperones will be assisting in dressing rooms.
