## General Policies

### General

- Pets, weapons, fire arms and fireworks are not permitted on the premises.
- The Diocese of West Texas expects all guests to comply with federal, state and local laws.

### Alcohol Policy

- Diocese of West Texas policy states alcohol use is not permitted in conference and meeting environments that include children.

### Smoking

- Smoking is not permitted in any room or interior space at the Conference Center.

### Medication and Controlled Substances

- Adult participants and parents of minors are responsible for the appropriate and legal administration of prescription and over-the-counter medications. Prescriptions and medications should be locked and access controlled. Controlled substances, other than those prescribed by a physician, are not permitted at the Conference Center.

### Supervision

- Parents are responsible for the supervision of their children.
- Parents and adults who have brought children other than their own are responsible for those children, too.
- All children and adults are expected to follow Conference Center policies and guidelines.

### Neighbors

- Noise travels easily and quickly through the walls and hallways. Be considerate walking outside your rooms and being aware of your voice volume.

### Safety

- All children on the beach must be supervised by one of the adults who brought them to the Conference Center.
- Please wear shoes and walk on the boardwalk.

### Vehicles

- Parking areas are located below Conference Center buildings and around the tower. Conference Center is not responsible for damages that may be sustained at MICC.

### Personal Items – including sports equipment, electronics, books, etc.

- The Conference Center is not responsible for any personal items.
