What Students Should Bring

Students are required to provide their own US Coast Guard Life Jacket. Students will be required to wear life jackets while aboard boats during class time. Water compatible shoes must be worn at all time. Ideally, shoes will be white soled and easily fastened. Tennis shoes, velcro-fastened sandals, deck shoes, and sailing boots are all acceptable. Sailing is a water sport and students should expect to get sprayed or wet on occasion. Students should wear or bring clothing to class that will keep them dry. A windbreaker, sailing rain gear, warm jacket, sweatshirt, towel, hat, sunscreen, sunglasses and warm dry change of clothes are strongly recommended and should be stored in a duffle bag or backpack.
