Dear RISE Upper Camp Parents:

Thank you for choosing RISE Upper Camp! We have received your registration and look forward to welcoming your child to *RISE Rewired 2020*. Please find below pertinent information regarding this camp season.

Important Dates and Camp Day Schedule

- Camp will run from Monday, June 29th through Friday, July 31st.
- The camp day will run from 8:45 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. for full day campers and from 8:45 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. for half day campers.
- There is no camp on Friday, July 3rd.

Drop-off Policy

- Upper Camp drop-off will begin at 8:45.
- Parents/guardians enter Moses Brown's campus via the gates closest to the softball field (*between K and B on campus map*). Please consult the enclosed Campus Map to help find this point and the other points mentioned below.
- The Upper Camp Drop-Off will take place at the Friends Hall Drop-Off Point (*I on the campus map*).
- ***On the first day of camp, parents or guardians will receive a Car ID Tag that they will need to place on their rearview mirrors from that point on for drop-off and pick-up.*** The Car ID Tags for Upper Camp are green, and they will be labeled with the camper's last name and group number.
- Once a parent or guardian arrives at the Upper Camp Drop-Off Point, they will be greeted by a RISE Camp staff member who will ask them a series of questions from the RI Department of Health to ensure that their camper does not exhibit any symptoms associated with COVID-19. Please see the attached questionnaire, as this will prepare you for this portion of drop-off.
- If the parent confirms that their child does not exhibit symptoms associated with COVID-19 and has not been in contact with anyone else that does, the camper may exit the vehicle and go their stable group in the Grove.
- ***Please do not drop-off campers before reaching the Upper Camp Drop-Off Point and responding to the daily health questionnaire.***
- Any camper that has received parental permission to walk or bike to camp must submit a health questionnaire (attached) daily and wear a safety mask as soon as they arrive to the campus gates.
- Lastly, for everyone's health and safety, all staff members, campers, and parents/guardians must wear masks at drop-off.

Pick-Up Policy

- Pick-up will also take place at the Friends Hall Drop-Off Point (*I on the campus map*).
- Parents or guardians must place their green Car ID Tags on their rearview mirrors prior to reaching the Upper Camp Pick-Up Point.
- The first time a person arrives to pick-up a camper, they will need to provide an ID to verify that they are one of the people listed on the authorized pick-up list. ***We will not send a camper home with someone who we cannot identify or someone that is not on this list.***
- It is also necessary for everyone to wear protective masks during pick-up (i.e. staff, campers, and people authorized to pick-up).
- Parents/guardians must contact Allie or Jerrett if a camper needs to be picked-up early.

Lunch and Snack

- Unfortunately, we will not be able to offer food service at RISE Camp this summer.
- This year, campers will need to bring their own nut-free lunch.
- As campers' lunches will not be refrigerated, please pack appropriate foods and cold packs.
- We will not be able to provide snack for campers this year. Please pack at least one snack for your camper each day, keeping in mind our nut-aware policy.

Other General Guidelines

- Campers should bring sunscreen and a water bottle to camp every day.
- We ask that campers leave their valuables (tablets, phones, jewelry, or toys) at home, as we cannot take responsibility for items lost or stolen on campus.
- Cell phone use is not permitted during camp hours without permission from a member of the administrative staff.
- We ask that campers use our office phone to contact parents/guardians. We have an office assistant present to answer phones at all times and to relay messages to campers.

Additional Safety Protocols for RISE Camp 2020

- *Parents or guardians must send 2 safety masks with their camper.*
- Campers will remain in weekly stable groups of 15 people or less, including counselors.
- Everyone must wear protective masks at drop-off and pick-up every day.
- Staff and campers will wear masks when social distancing is not possible, even within stable groups.
- Materials that are shared across stable groups will be sanitized at the end of each activity.
- If a camper shows any signs of illness, they will be seen by our camp nurse and wait in a designated area away from other campers until they can be picked up. We ask that parents and guardians have a plan in place in case they need to pick-up their camper before the standard pick-up time.

Half-Day and Extended Day

- This year, we will only offer a half-day program to campers that begin the camp day at RISE. The hours for half-day campers are 8:45-12:30.
- We will not offer an extended day program this summer.
