

## **Welcome to Summer 2025**

We are so excited to be open and to have your family join us this spring/summer.

Below is important information regarding arrival, departure, and camp protocols. Please read carefully, it is all important and it will make your parent experience better.

New Location - Summer Camp - Santa Monica - Lifeguard Tower 11 1100 Pacific Coast Highway, Santa Monica, 90403 Drop off and pick up are in parking lot 4N

**Camp Hours:** 9:00 am - 3:00 pm

## Please pack the following items for your camper:

- Towel
- Sunscreen (spray sunscreen for the body and a stick for the face)
- Flip Flops/Sand Shoes
- Lunch/Snack/Refillable Water Bottle
- Hat/Sunglasses (if your child is a sunglass kind of kid)
- Hoodie or warm layers (we also have SDKC Hoodies for sale)
- Please make sure to label all items with the child's name.

## Drop-Off Information: 9:00 am - 9:30 am

- Drop off is in lot 4 North, located at 1100 Pacific Coast Highway, 90403, immediately adjacent to SM Fire Station 7. We are the small parking lot without a parking attendant located immediately north of the fire station. You can access the parking lot from PCH coming through the McClure Tunnel heading north on PCH, turn left into lot 4. You can also access by coming down the California Incline and turning left (south) onto PCH and turning right into lot 4. You will not need a parking pass to drop off or pick up. If you plan on staying longer than 15-30 minutes you will need to purchase a parking permit from the pay station in the lot.
- Monday morning's will take longer as all campers need to be signed in for the first time as well as get sized for their rash guards. Please be patient on the first morning. You do not need to arrive right at 9:00 am to drop off. You can come anytime between 9:00 - 9:30 am.
- All campers must arrive wearing their bathing suit and rash guard. (Monday morning, all new campers will get their camp rash guard).

• End of the Day Pick-up: Pick up is 3:00 - 3:30 pm. For pickup at the end of the day please park your car and line up to check out your campers. Once you sign them out we will walk up from the beach to you. Campers are not allowed to be picked up without being signed out. Please make sure that your authorized pick up list is accurate. We will not release a camper to a person not listed as an authorized pick up

## Early Pick Up Policy

- If you need to drop off late or pick up early we need to know in advance. Please let us know in the morning at drop off.
- NO EARLY PICK UP BETWEEN 2:45 3:00 pm.
- **No Extended Care:** we are not currently offering extended care. All campers must be picked up no later than 3:30 pm on camp days. If you have an emergency please text Sina Monjazeb, 310-569-1274, to let him know you are running late.

**Water Bottles:** Campers need to bring a refillable water bottle. We have water coolers for them to be able to refill their water bottles. Please try to avoid sending single use plastic water bottles.

**Lunch and Snacks:** We do not provide any type of food or snacks at camp. Please make sure you pack a lunch and snack for your child. Campers will not be allowed to make purchases at the snack shack. We are excited to be offering a lunch program for campers through **Children's Menu**. You can order for the week of camp and have lunch delivered for your camper/s through their website, **childrensmenu.com**. You will also receive a pdf with lunch program details emailed to you when you register. There is a link to register and order on our website.

**Sunscreen:** Campers will need to bring their own sunscreen. We suggest a spray for the body and a sunscreen stick for faces. Please sunscreen your child/ren **before** camp! We will reapply before lunch. **Please send spray sunscreen as we do not want campers and staff to have to rub lotion on their bodies.** 

We want to stress that we need your children to understand that our rules are in place for everyone's safety and protection. With that said, any camper who cannot comply with our protocols will be sent home to keep the rest of the campers and staff safe. No refunds will be issued for a camper who is sent home.
