



## Welcome to Summer 2026

We are so excited to be open and to have your family join us this summer. Below is important information regarding arrival, departure, and camp protocols. Please read carefully, it is all important and it will make your camper & parent experience better.

### **Please pack the following items for your camper:**

- **SPRAY SUNSCREEN FOR THE BODY & SUNSCREEN FACE STICK**
  - DO NOT SEND CREAM FOR YOUR CHILD/REN
- TOWEL
- CROCS/SANDALS
- LUNCH, SNACKS & A REFILLABLE WATER BOTTLE
- HAT
- Hoodie or warm layers (we also have SDKC Hoodies for sale)

**Please make sure to label all items with the child's name.**

### **Drop-Off: 9:00am - 9:30am**

- Drop-off is located in the Will Rogers Beach parking lot. Entrance at PCH/Temescal Cyn., 15900 Pacific Coast Highway, Pacific Palisades, 90272.
- You will need a parking pass for drop off & pick up. A Sandy Days team member will be at the parking kiosk Monday mornings from 8:45 am - 9:30 am to hand out parking passes. Please place it on your dashboard. Once you enter the lot, make a u-turn and head south to our bright yellow cabanas and welcome table. You will need to park in a spot and sign your camper/s in.
- If you arrive later or need an additional pass/es please let the parking attendant know you are coming to Sandy Days and we will provide you with an extra pass. *(parking passes are not to be used for anything other than pick up or drop off at Sandy Days.)*
- Monday mornings can take longer as all campers need to be signed in for the first time as well as get sized for their rash guards. Please be patient on the first morning. You do not need to arrive right at 9:00 am to drop off. You can come anytime between 9:00 - 9:30 am.
- All campers must arrive wearing their bathing suits and rash guard.  
*(Monday mornings, all **new** campers will get a camp rash guard.)*

### **Pick-up: 3:00 - 3:30pm**

- Please pick up your child/ren no later than 3:30pm. Campers are not allowed to be picked up without being signed out. We will not release a camper/s to a person/s not listed as an authorized pick up.
- If you need to pick up your camper early, we appreciate as much notice as possible. You can let us know at morning drop-off or text the onsite director during the day. Please note that we are unable to accommodate early pick-ups between 2:45–3:00 PM, as this is an important transition time when campers are changing out of wet clothes, gathering their belongings and projects, and preparing for end-of-day dismissal

### **Extended Care: 3:30pm - 4:30pm**

- We are happy to offer extended care again as an add-on. Campers must be picked up no later than 4:30 pm for extended care. Campers need to be signed up in advance. If you need to add extended care for the day please check with us when signing your camper in and we will do our best to accommodate that request but we cannot guarantee it.
- Please note that our bright yellow Sandy Days cabanas are fully broken down and packed into our vans by approximately 3:45 PM each day. If you are picking up during Extended Care, please head directly to Tower 10 to locate our staff and campers.
- If you have an emergency please text Sina Monjazebe, 310-569-1274, to let him know you are running late

**Water Bottles:** Campers need to bring a refillable water bottle. We have water coolers for them to be able to refill their water bottles. Please try to avoid sending single use plastic water bottles.

**Lunch and Snacks:** We do not provide any type of food or snacks at camp. Please make sure you pack a lunch and snack for your child. Campers will not be allowed to make purchases at the snack shack. We are excited to be offering a lunch program for campers through **Children's Menu**. You can order for the week of camp and have lunch delivered for your camper/s through their website, [childrensmenu.com](http://childrensmenu.com). You will also receive a pdf with lunch program details emailed to you when you register. There is a link to register and order on our website as well.

**Sunscreen:** Campers will need to bring their own sunscreen. **To ensure proper sun protection, we require that you send a spray sunscreen for the body and a sunscreen stick for faces.** Our staff cannot apply creams on campers. Please sunscreen your child/ren **before** camp! We will reapply before lunch & again in the afternoon. **Please send spray sunscreen as we do not allow our staff to rub lotion on campers.**

We want to stress that we need you and your children to understand that our rules are in place for everyone's safety and protection. With that said, any camper who cannot comply with our protocols will be sent home to keep the rest of the campers and staff safe. No refunds will be issued for a camper who is sent home.

Thank you for entrusting your children to us. We are dedicated to making this spring fun for all.
