Communication:

Please be sure to check your email frequently for updates and notices from camp. I will use the email you have included on your UltraCamp registration. Please be sure that this is an email address that you regularly check.

What to Bring:

Campers should wear comfortable clothes and sturdy footwear (sneakers and socks are highly recommended) as they will be participating in a variety of activities throughout the day. We are asking that each child bring a tote bag or backpack that they will carry with them throughout the day. This bag should contain:

- Cold water bottle (we can refill throughout the day)
- Sunscreen

Please label all items brought to camp with your child's name, as they can be easily misplaced during the day. Please do not allow your child to wear flip-flops or sneakers with wheels, for safety reasons.

Kent Place cannot be held responsible for personal items brought to camp. Please do not allow your child to bring objects of great value.

Cell Phones:

Campers will be required to leave their cell phones in the camp office while they are attending classes and participating in activities. Campers may only use their cell phone with permission from camp staff.

Lunch & Snack Info:

Campers will receive at least one nut-free snack daily. If your child has severe allergies or dietary restrictions, they are welcome to bring their own snack. Lunch is provided in our Dining Hall each day. Information will be sent in advance if money is needed for lunch on a field trip.

Carpools/Alternate Pick Up/Extended Care:

If your child will be part of a carpool or is going home with someone who does not usually pick them up, please inform us, in writing (via email), of your arrangement.

If your child requires Extended Care (morning or afternoon), you can register them online. We have daily drop-in and weekly registration options.

What happens at Passport Camp?

Passport campers will participate in specialized group activities (such as painting, pickleball or STEM challenges) as well as Senior Camp classes. There is at least one field trip each week in addition to a trip for ice cream each week. Passport campers also participate in a variety of community service activities on and off campus.

Passport campers are encouraged to participate in All Camp Spirit Days, but participation is not required.

Nurse:

We will have a nurse on campus for health needs and emergencies. Please bring any medications, along with a doctor's order, on the first day of camp and speak with our nurse in the Primary School. Please contact the nurse with any health/medication questions or concerns (loverns@kentplace.org).
