Pre Camp Notifications

Welcome to the Summer of 2024 at Kent Place Camp! We look forward to an exciting summer. This letter will give you an overview of this week's activities, special events, and procedures.

## Important Information from the Director of Summer & Auxiliary Programs:

Please be sure you have an updated email address on your Ultracamp Account. Most of our communication comes via email. <u>You can do this by clicking here</u> and then clicking on your name to edit your email address.

Please also make sure that the <u>Kent Place Summer Program Information Form</u> is up-to-date. This form includes medical information, photo permissions, and our Acceptable Use Policy at Kent Place. You will need to have this filled out in order for your child to come to camp on their first scheduled day.

## What to Bring

- Campers should wear play clothes and sturdy footwear; sneakers and socks are highly recommended.
- It is always a good idea to bring a bathing suit, a towel, sandals/flip flops for water play but most times we will notify you ahead of time if we are doing water activities.
- Water bottle: We require that you also send your camper with a water bottle so they can stay hydrated. Please make sure your child's name is labeled on the bottle.
- Sunscreen: Campers should both come to camp with a base of sunscreen and bring extra to apply as needed throughout the day. Your cooperation is appreciated.
- Tote bag/backpack and towel: Please send a tote bag each day to hold personal belongings. We are also asking that each child bring a towel in their bag to sit anywhere on campus.
- Please put your child's name on all items brought to camp, as things can be misplaced during the day. If you believe your child has lost an item, please let me know and I'll have your child and his/her counselor look in the *Lost and Found* bin located outside the Fieldhouse.

Kent Place Camp cannot be held responsible for personal items brought to camp. Please do not allow your child to bring objects of great value, such as a Switch, iPod, gizmo, smartwatch, cell phone, iPad, or small toys to camp.

#### Every Wednesday is Water Day at Senior Camp. Please have campers wear their bathing suits to camp for water activities in the morning. Campers must have something on their feet during water play to prevent injury. Campers should bring a towel and change of clothes for after water play.

## DROP OFF AND PICK UP

Due to continued construction we are evaluating new drop off and pick up locations for the summer of 2024. This location will be updated prior to week 1 of camp.

During their first day they will get a camp t-shirt and a car tag. Please display this tag on your dashboard when picking up your child. If your child will not be present on the first day of his or her session, please call the camp office, at (908) 273-0900, ext. 220 or email <u>daycamp@kentplace.org</u> to let us know when to expect you so we can be sure you receive these important items.

Campers should arrive between 8:45 and 9:00 a.m. Please do not send your child to camp earlier than 8:45 a.m. We are asking all adults to please stay in the car at drop off and pick up.

If you are arriving after 9:00 a.m. please speak with the security guard so they can contact Eric at Senior Camp.

Pick up will begin promptly at 4:00. If you anticipate arriving after 4:05 please contact the camp office.

## Lunch & Snack Info

Hot lunch entree with a dessert and drink is provided daily. Plain pasta with marinara on the side, cheese sandwich, salad bar and bagel with CC or butter is also available daily. The summer 2024 menu will be sent out in June.

Snack is provided in the afternoon.

Morning half day campers will receive lunch before leaving at 12:30-12:45. Anyone arriving at 12:30 will not receive lunch.
