



SENIOR STAFF PACKING LIST

REQUIRED:

- Sheets (flat and fitted) for your bed (please note whether you are in a queen or single). You can sleep in a sleeping bag, but we ask you not to sleep directly on the bed without your own sheet or blanket between you and the bed.
- Bar soap and laundry detergent are not provided. Please bring. Hand soap, trash bags, and toilet paper is provided. Please refill the hand soap, don't discard the pump bottles.
- Light jacket, sweatshirt
- Hiking boots or work boots
- Work gloves
- Modest casual clothing (see below)
- Dressier church attire for Sunday worship and meal (guys wear collared shirt or button-down and slacks—boys staff supervisors wear ties on Sunday, girls wear dresses or skirts & blouses or slacks)
- Modest one-piece swimsuit or tankini and beach towel
- Any extra money for books, snacks, or WSS gear
- Finally, a servant's heart and smile!

EMPLOYMENT DOCUMENTS (you cannot get paid if you don't bring these documents)

1. Photo ID (Passport, drivers license, or military ID)
2. Proof of citizenship (Social Security Card or birth certificate—a copy will work)

OPTIONAL:

1. **Recommended attire for staff introductions, weekly activities, etc.:** Western duds, international outfit, bandanas, July 4th gear
2. Small pocket knife

What clothes to bring (and not to bring)

Our intent is an environment in which love for the Lord and for others is our highest value. Because of this, dressing modestly in this environment, conservatively defined to avoid offending a broad spectrum of Christian traditions represented by our paying guests, is one important way to express that love. We seek to be a blessing to all that come here, and while there will always be some that have stricter/higher standards, we do want to strive for a reasonable standard of modesty. The standards below are a potentially imperfect attempt to provide an objective standard for a subjective principle (modesty) and are not meant to be construed as innately sinful, simply a guide to how we are attempting to best love one another and our guests in the summer program.

Specifics: No tank tops (span over shoulder must be the width of your hand) or bare midriffs (front or back). No excessively ripped/torn clothing. All undergarments must be covered. Suggestive or tight clothing is not permitted. Shirts are required anywhere guests are or likely



to be present. Shorts must extend to end of your fist when standing straight with your hands in a fist at your side. An untucked shirt should not extend beyond the bottom of shorts. Ensure any logos or phrases on shirts are appropriate for a Christian, family environment (i.e. no shirts that promote alcohol, have suggestive words or pictures, etc.)
