



SENIOR STAFF PACKING LIST

REQUIRED:

- A servant's heart and smile
- Bible, notebook, pen/pencil, highlighter
- Light jacket, sweatshirt
- Hiking boots or work boots
- Work gloves
- Flashlight
- Face masks to have on hand
- Modest casual clothing (see modesty policy below)
- Dressier church attire for Sundays (guys wear long pants and ties, girls wear dresses or skirts & blouses)
- **Attire for fun staff spirit days (every Tuesday this summer!):** Hawaiian-style shirts
- Modest one-piece swimsuit or tankini and beach towel
- Toiletries, insect repellent, sunscreen
- Any extra money for books, snacks, or WSS gear
- Sheets for your bed at the hotel (you will be told what size)
- Towels for your personal use at hotel and on AO!
- Water bottle (we recommend 32 oz. or more)

OPTIONAL:

- **Recommended attire for staff introductions, weekly activities, etc.:** Western duds, international outfit, bandanas, July 4th gear
- Ball hat and beanie
- Small pocket knife
- Headlamp (extra batteries)

MODESTY POLICY

Men: Modest athletic or casual attire is acceptable. No tank tops, no ripped/torn shirts/shorts/pants. **Women:** Shorts of modest length (should cover most of the thigh area) are acceptable but tank tops, spaghetti straps or bare midriffs (front or back) are not permitted. Ensure shirts cover waistbands. Suggestive or tight clothing is not permitted.

Bottom line: If in doubt, you probably shouldn't wear it. Ensure any logos or phrases on shirts are appropriate for a Christian, family environment (i.e. no shirts that promote alcohol, have suggestive words or pictures, etc.). Ministry Team members retain the right to ask staffers to change if they find clothing inappropriate for the WSS environment.

In addition, in the spirit of looking professional and of not offending guests with a wide variety of convictions and sensitivities, we ask you to comply with our appearance standards. This includes no unnatural hair dye, gaudy piercings (this includes any earrings worn by males), and some tattoos. If necessary, the Center Director will ask the staffer to remove the piercing or cover the tattoos for the duration of the staff.
