

## CAMPER PACKET

## Drop off and Pick Up

Drop off will be at the chapel (the building with the stain glass windows) at Mt. Zion Baptist Church (4096 E. Cherokee Dr., 30115). Please enter at the **main entrance** of the church and drive behind the Family Life Center (Gym) and main church building. There will be a short driveway to the right to drive up to the side of the chapel. **All parents must remain in their vehicles.** A staff member will assist your camper out of the car for check in.

Pick up will be located behind the main building in the back field. There will be a carpool line. **Parents must stay in vehicles and present an ID each day, even if we know you.** In the case of rain, pick up will be located at the chapel. Parents will need to drive behind the Family Life Center (Gym) and the main church building to get in line for carpool. There will be a staff member there to direct you.

Late pick up will be located at the big tree and porch swing between the main church and chapel. Please enter the main entrance and drive strait ahead until you see the tree and porch swing. **Parents must stay in vehicles and present an ID each day, even if we know you.** At 5 p.m. post camp will move inside to the gym or chapel. A "Hide and Seek Day Camp" sign will be posted by the door to the chapel or gym depending on where the group is located.

## What to bring:

- 1. Bag or Back Pack

- 3. Snack
- 4. Post Camp Snack (if needed)
- 5. Water Bottle
- 6. Sunscreen
- 7. Hand Sanitizer
- 8. Leave all electronics, toys, phones, smart watches etc. at home.
- 9. Label every camper item, including water bottle.
