Dear Camp Meeting Attendee,

We are pleased you are joining us for Camp Meeting June 14-18. Many prayerful plans have already been made but we ask that you join in asking for the outpouring of the Holy Spirit on this gathering of God's people.

PLEASE read all of this letter as it contains IMPORTANT information you will need.

On-site arrivals should take place from 1:00 pm to 5:30 pm on Tuesday, June 14. Please stop at the information desk in the Administration Building to pick up a Camp Meeting brochure and be directed to your lodging. After this, registration/information staff will be available during the times listed below. (If you are arriving with a trailer, you can go directly to Terrace Campground where someone will assist you in finding your campsite and parking within the site. If you are unable to locate someone, please call 443-741-2610).

The information/registration office will be just inside the entrance of the Highland View Academy Ad Building. To reach someone by phone please call 443-741-2610. Camp Meeting hours will be Tuesday – 1:00 to 5:30 pm, Wednesday-Friday – 10:00 am to 5:00 pm (closed during lunch). During the main meeting hours, please visit staff at the information table at the entrance of the gymnasium through the Ad Building.

Sabbath Hours: The information/registration staff will be available to assist you at the information tables during the Sabbath hours. However, business transactions and furniture moving services will be suspended until after Sabbath hours.

RVs and Tent Sites: The RV and tent sites will be numbered. Please be careful to settle into the correct site in order to avoid the necessity of moving. You wouldn't want someone else in your spot. If clarification is needed, please see information/registration personnel or the Camp Meeting Coordinator. Please have all items removed from Canvas Tents by 9:00 am on Sunday so the tent crew can begin their work. Trash can be left in the red dumpster by the last driveway into the campground.

Dorm Rooms: Please see the dean on duty in the dorm to check in and receive your key. A refundable key deposit of \$35.00 per key will need to be paid on-site if it was not paid with your reservation. At check out your deposit will be refunded with the return of the key(s) and a clean room. The standard room includes two beds, two desks, two chairs, and a sink. You will need to bring your own bedding. Check out is 7:00-9:00 am Sunday morning.

Meal Tickets: Meal tickets are available for purchase online at www.ccosda.org/campmeeting. They may also be purchased at the cafeteria. Prices are as follows:

Adults - \$7.00

Children (ages 1-12) - \$5.00

Meal tickets must be purchased prior to Sabbath. There are no refunds for unused meal tickets.

Meals will be served beginning Tuesday for dinner; Wednesday through Saturday for breakfast, lunch, and dinner; and Sunday for breakfast.

Division Activity Fees: \$35.00 for Juniors, Earliteens, Youth, and \$15.00 for Young Adults. Fee covers a wide variety of activities for the week, details are on our website.

Parking: For everyone's convenience and safety please cooperate with the following guidelines.

- The area behind each dorm is for loading and unloading only. When you are finished please move to a designated parking area.
- Do not block access to the dumpsters.
- In the tent and trailer area, please be careful to park completely off the traffic lanes so other vehicles can pass. If you have guests, be considerate and ask them not to park in front of other occupied camp sites.
- The Administration Building parking lot is reserved for the handicapped and employees.
- The Dining Hall parking lot is for meal time parking only.

General Information:

- All attendees are asked to dress in harmony with the principles of Christian propriety. Modest attire encourages a more worshipful environment.
- Each evening there is a 10:30 pm quiet time. Please be respectful of others on the campus.
- For safety, cleanliness, and comfort, **no pets are allowed on the campgrounds**.
- Unauthorized use of bicycles, minibikes, motorcycles, and golf carts is not permitted. Special permission can only be granted by the Camp Meeting Coordinator, Jerry Lutz.
- Children under 18 years-old must be under the care of a designated adult to stay on the grounds.
- Firearms, illegal drugs, tobacco, and alcohol are not permitted on the grounds.
- For medical emergencies, please call 911. For minor medical concerns please contact the information/registration office or information table and they can contact an on-duty camp nurse. You can also call the Camp Meeting information number at 443-741-2610.
- Campfires are not permitted in the tent and trailer area, or any other area on campus.
- Cooking is not allowed in the dorms. This includes microwaves, toaster ovens, hot plates, griddles, etc.
- Pool Hours: Wed-Fri - 1 to 5 pm.
 - Modest swimwear is required. One-piece suits or a shirt over the suit for ladies/girls.
 - Lifeguards are on duty and their instructions need to be followed.
 - Children under the age of six must be accompanied by an adult.
