CAMPER PACKING LIST

- Any specialized equipment that your camper requires
- Bedding: twin sheets, blanket (or sleeping bag) & pillow
- Toiletries: toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, shampoo, deodorant, sunscreen
- Shower towel and pool towel
- Swimsuit (girls' should cover stomach completely or wear a dark shirt over) and shoes to wear to the pool)
- Closed-toed shoes and socks (required for some activities, open-toed shoes with backstraps are allowed for everything else)
- T-shirts (no spaghetti straps, tight fitting shirts or shirts that completely cover shorts)
- Shorts/pants (must be at least fingertip length, girls' Nike shorts are okay)
- Hoodie or jacket (some indoor activities are in rooms with strong A/C)
- Undergarments
- Appropriate sleepwear
- Costumes for parties (see theme night list below)
- Water bottle
- Flashlight, backpack and rain jacket/poncho
- Pirty laundry bag
- Bible, notebook and pens
- Noise-canceling headphones (if needed)
- Letters for mail drop (if desired)
- Signed copy of guidelines AND medical forms (do not pack, bring to check in)

Notes/Tips:

- Try to keep all luggage down to 1-2 bags with no loose items (trunks are a great way to pack)
- Please label all bags and individual items with the camper's name
- Pon't break the bank on costumes, utilize thrift stores and homemade costumes!
