



Here is a list of things to bring, and not to bring, to camp which may be helpful to you as registration day gets closer.

### **What to Bring**

- \* Bible
- \* Everyday play/activity wear
- \* Rain gear
- \* Sweatshirt or jacket
- \* Long pants (required for some activities)
- \* Appropriate footwear (sandals and closed toes shoes like tennis shoes)
- \* Camp church clothes
- \* Insect repellent
- \* Sunscreen
- \* Water bottle
- \* Camera to capture all the fun memories!
- \* Flashlight
- \* Modest swimsuit (one piece for ladies)
- \* Toothbrush & toothpaste
- \* Shampoo
- \* Comb/brush
- \* Towels, washcloth (beach and bathing towels)
- \* Sleeping bag/pillow
- \* Medications (if applicable)
- \* Store money (if not already applied to campers acct during registration)

\*\*\*Note, for your safety, ALL campers must bring a pair of long pants and close-toed, full coverage shoes when at the barn\*\*\*

### **What Not to Bring**

Due to safety and health concerns, we request that campers not bring the following items - skateboards, jewelry of any kind (any piercings must be removed before coming to camp), pets, knives, guns ammunition, fireworks, tobacco, alcohol, illegal drugs, or cultist items such as tarot cards or Ouija boards to camp.

### **Dress Code**
