
# TANALIAN TICKER

# **Deeply Known & Fully Loved**

During Summer Camp, we will look at how God fully knows and fully loves us. Our theme verse for the summer is:

Psalm 139:13-16 "For you created my inmost being: you knit me together in my mother's womb. I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your works are wonderful, I know that full well. My frame was not hidden from you when I was made in the secret place, when I was woven together in the depths of the earth. Your eyes saw my unformed body, all the days ordained for me were written in your book before one of them came to be."

### **Activities**

During the week of camp we offer different skill classes for your learning and fun. You may choose from archery, riflery, canoeing, crafts, basketball, fishing, games, and many other outdoor adventures. Each week we have all-camp activities and a hikes that require good footwear. **Please bring proper shoes!** Beach day is another all-camp activity, so come prepared to play in the water!

### Medical

To enable us to care for your child's special needs, please clearly advise us of all physical limitations, allergies, and dietary or activity restrictions. Please send all required medication in the *original bottle*.

Don't forget inhalers, camp is very dusty and your child will be very active.

Camp personnel will administer all medication. If any medical emergencies arise while your child is at camp, we have a fulltime doctor and nurse available. We will alert you if your child has further medical needs during camp. Your child's safety and health is a primary concern for us!

# Flying to Camp

We will use the information you provided during registration regarding how you will be coming to camp.
