Bus Transportation

Bus Transportation is available on the first and last day of several Nebraska 4-H Resident Camp Sessions on a first come/ served basis. There is a \$30 fee for this service. Reservations are required in advance so the appropriate number of buses can be booked. Please note that we do not offer a refund for any bus transportation unless cancelled by the camp.

- The bus will pick up campers at the Eastern Nebraska 4-H Center in Gretna, NE and make one stop in Buffalo County Extension Office in Kearney, NE at approximately 2:15PM. The dates are: July 12, 2020; July 19, 2020; and July 26, 2020. The bus leaves at 12:00PM (NOON). Please arrive with your camper 45 minutes prior to this time. Parents who miss the bus will be responsible for transporting their camper to camp. Please make sure that you camper has already eaten lunch and gone to the bathroom before boarding the bus. You might consider bringing a lunch for them to eat while checking in and waiting to board the bus.
- On the return trip, the Bus WILL LEAVE CAMP EARLY at 1:00PM the bus will drop off campers at Buffalo County Extension Office in Kearney, NE at 3:15PM and Eastern Nebraska 4-H Center in Gretna at 5:30PM on July 16, 2020; July 23, 2020, and July 30, 2020. Please arrive 15 minutes early to greet your camper, and please be sure to bring a PHOTO ID for sign out with the bus staff. Only Authorized pickups indicated on your UltraCamp account will be able to pick up.
- Any changes or emergencies that would affect campers' pick up or dropoff times or location will be communicated with parents/ guardians via email.

Bus Rules

In order to provide a safe and enjoyable bus trip for campers, counselors, and the bus driver, please review the following rules with your camper.

- All campers must stay on the door side of the bus during loading and unloading.
- All campers must remain seated and facing forward at all times.
- The noise level on the bus should not exceed the comfort level of the bus driver.
- No electronics (iPods, game boys, etc.), food or candy.

The bus will make one stop at <u>Buffalo</u> County Extenison in Kearney to pick up additional Campers. The bus will arrive at approximately +/- 2:15 PM for Camper Pickup. 	 The bus leaves camp for the Eastern Nebraska State 4-H Camp at 1:00PM. The bus will make one stop at Buffalo County Extenison in Kearney to Drop off campers. The bus will arrive in Kearney at approximately +/- 3:15 PM for Camper Pickup. The bus will continue on to the Eastern Nebraska 4-H Camp with an expected arrival
	time of 5:30PM.
 The bus ride is approximately 5 hours long. Parents who miss the bus will be responsible for transporting their camper to camp. No refunds will be given for transportation. Please have your camper EAT LUNCH BEFORE getting on the bus. You might consider bringing a lunch while checking in and waiting for the bus to leave. • Take I-80 West towards Lincoln, NE.

- Take Exit 432 (Nebraska Crossing Outlet Mall and Flying J TruckStop.)
- Turn Left (South) on Highway 31.
- The entrance to camp is approximately 5 miles south from the entrance to the Flying J.

From Lincoln, Nebraska:

- Take I-80 East towards Omaha, NE.
- Cross the Platte River and take Exit 432 (Nebraska Crossing Outlet Mall and Flying J Truck Stop.
- Turn right (South) onto Highway 31.
- The entrance to camp is approximately 5 miles south from the entrance to the Flying J.

From North Platte, Nebraska:

- Take I-80 East towards Lincoln, NE.

- Arrive at the Buffalo County Extension Office. Bus will meet on the south side of the Extension office parking lot.

- Take I-80 West towards Grand Island, NE.
- Take Exit 272 44N/ S2nd Ave in Kearney.
- Turn left onto W 11th St.
- Turn Left on M Avenue
- Turn right onto E 34 St.
- Arrive at the Buffalo County Extension Office. Bus will meet on the south side of the Extension office parking lot.
