Guide to Silver Lake's Camp Store

Camp Store Accounts allow your camper to purchase Silver Lake memorabilia, such as t-shirts, sweatshirts, water bottles, and other fun keepsakes.

They will also have the option to donate to the Missions Organizations Silver Lake supports. Each summer, we support up to three non-profit organizations through our Missions program. Campers will learn about these organizations and then can support them through a camp store donation. Please talk with your camper about an appropriate amount to donate.

NEW IN 2025 - Silver Lake will provide 1 frozen treat (ice cream or popsicle) and 1 drink to all campers every afternoon. Additional snacks and drinks will not be available to purchase at the camp store.

We recommend setting aside at least \$5 for Missions and a total of \$25-\$40 per week. T-shirts are \$10-15, souvenirs are \$5-\$15, sweatshirts are \$30-40.

The Camp Store account system is designed to prevent lost or stolen money during the week. During checkout, any money above \$10 left in the Camp Store will be returned in cash with your camper.

Remaining balances under \$10 will be considered a donation unless you call the office by 3 pm on Thursday before checkout.

Put money in your campers' Store Account

Store accounts are set up as part of the registration process. If you have already completed the registration(s), follow the directions below to add money to the camp store account(s).

1. Go to <https://www.ultracamp.com/clientlogin.aspx?idCamp=399&campCode=slc> and log in.
2. Click the menu icon  then click on "Camp Store" from the list.
3. Click "Store Deposits."
4. Enter the desired amount and follow prompts to complete payment.

Any remaining balance can be left for another session of camp or can be refunded for cash during checkout.

Money left at the end of the camp season in August will be donated.

Your registration account must have a summer camp registration on it to set up a store account.

Photo Collections

Photo Collections are a great way to remember the session, with hundreds of photos from our camp photographer. At the end of the camp session, all participants will receive a link to view all the photos online (with a Silver Lake watermark.) If you would like to download any of the photos or order prints, there will be a per-photo fee that will be charged directly through the photo collection webpage.
