

FAMILY CAMP II CLASSES

Amphibians

Discover the secret life of frogs, toads and salamanders. You can help care for the amphibians we have in the nature center. Learn about their life cycles and how God created them with unique survival skills! Become experts at finding amphibians.

Archery (ages 12+ years)

Sharpen your aim and shooting skills. Your instructor will show you the safest and best way to enjoy the sport. With practice, maybe you can hit the bullseye! When you sign up, you are signing up for the entire week, not for the day. Through the week, you will learn the basics of archery and sharpen your skills. A reminder that all archery students must be at least 12 years old and able to pull back a bow.

Basketry (cost \$15-50, ages 10+ years)

Try your hand at the age-old skill of weaving your own basket! Use your creativity to make a reed basket you can use in your home, give as a gift, or just use as decoration. Join us to weave a basket as beautiful as it is functional! Open to all ages, but anyone younger than 10 must be accompanied by an adult.

Ceramics (cost depends)

Campers will have the choice to paint a mug, vase, cookie jar, and more. They will also learn that Bisque is not a soup and greenware is not found in the kitchen drawer. Pick your own ceramic (\$1-25 per piece) and explore the art of glazes and stains! Open to all ages, but anyone younger than 10 must be accompanied by an adult.

Challenge Course

Climb a tower or stack milk crates, navigate the High Ropes Course, soar on the Giant Swing, and conquer the Team Wall in the Challenge Course class. Support and encourage each other as you face challenges, build trust, and strengthen your family bonds through these exciting and rewarding adventures! Dry clothes and closed-toed shoes required.

Fishing

Join our Waterfront Fishing Class, where we will experience the fun and excitement of fishing while learning essential angling skills! Whether you're a first-time fisher or are already hooked, this class offers a hands-on opportunity to improve casting, knot tying, bait selection, and fish identification all in Lake Shallenberger at Camp Au Sable!

Horseback Riding

Whether you are a beginner or an experienced rider, in this class you can develop your confidence and skills through group riding lessons, guided trail rides, and more! Classes split based on experience. **Long pants and closed-toed shoes required.**

Kids Activity-A-Day (ages 4-8 years)

A class designed for kids ages 4-8, with a daily sports activity meeting on the ball field and enjoying some time together playing and being active!

Kids Craft-A-Day (ages 3-9 years)

Kids will enjoy trying their hand at fun and exciting art projects! Stop by each day for a different crafty experience! Open for ages 3-9.

Kids Gymnastics

Gymnastics classes involve large and small motor skill activities including warm-ups to directive music, group games, and skills on the bars, balance beam, and floor. There are two different gymnastics class options. Children between the ages of 2 and 5 meet each weekday morning from 10:30 until 11:30, while children ages 6 to 9 meet each weekday morning from 11:45-12:45. These classes will meet in the athletic shed. If children are not comfortable being left unassisted, parents are welcome to stay; parents are required to stay for 2-year-olds.

Phone Photography (ages 12+ years)

Learn basic photo tricks and hacks to make your phone photography amazing! Learn to use the photo editing settings already in your camera. Each person signed up should have their own phone to use with a functional camera. Open for ages 12+.

Heidi Agy is a Creative Director at a photo studio and directs photo shoots and videos all the time. By the end of the week she will help you take your photos to the next level!

Plein Air Art (cost \$25, ages 12+ years)

This class uses different art mediums such as watercolors, pastels, and paint to create a vivid picture of nature. You will be taken around Camp Au Sable to put the beauty of camp onto paper yourself! Open to ages 12+.

Pottery (cost \$25, ages 12+ years)

Learn how to create with clay using different techniques such as sculpting, wheel-throwing, and hand-building. Open to ages 12+.

Sewing (costs \$5-15, ages 9+ years)

Snorkling
