Dear Campers and Families,

We want your time at Camp Au Sable to be safe and enjoyable. Camp Au Sable provides basic medical services for campers and staff. Although we may be able to provide some similar services, we are not a doctor's office or an emergency department. We are unable to do insurance physicals or evaluate and treat chronic medical conditions.

We have Registered Nurses and Physicians who volunteer their time to provide evaluation and treatment for minor acute illnesses and injury. The Camp Au Sable Medical Clinic does not have the capacity to evaluate, monitor, and treat more than minor illnesses or injury.

Illnesses and/or injuries that require further diagnostic evaluation, or continuous monitoring, will be transferred to Munson Healthcare Grayling Hospital's Emergency Department.

If after the emergency department evaluation and treatment, it is deemed that the patient **can safely return** to camp activity, they will be integrated back into the program at camp.

If after the emergency department evaluation and treatment, it is deemed that the patient **cannot safely return** to camp activity, or they need a period of convalescence for recuperation and healing, then the medical team will start making arrangements to have the patient leave camp, to return to their home and/or family.

The final decision will be made by the Camp Au Sable Medical Team in conjunction with Camp Au Sable Administration. Thank you for your cooperation with their medical expertise and desires to keep Camp Au Sable safe and enjoyable for all.
