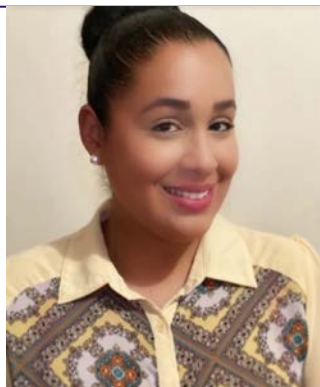

● Arrival

- Families will walk around the side walkway to the building and walk their camper to the back door of their classroom, where teachers will welcome campers directly into the classroom
- Newport camp families who drive to camp AND choose to escort their children to the backyard should park in River Market Garage, located at 20 North Blvd., and then walk their child(ren) to the Newport building.
 - Families may park anywhere on the first or second floor in the daily lot for up to 30 minutes, between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 9:30 a.m. on weekdays, Monday - Friday.
 - Any family who remains in the daily lot after the 30-minute period expires will be billed at an hourly rate by the garage's automated license plate reader. The school does not manage or reimburse for billed parking.
 - The garage lot should be used instead of the metered parking spots down the street from our building during the designated drop-off window.
 - Families who are completing a quick drop-off may still do so in front of our Newport building. Please keep in mind that if there is any delay or need to walk a student beyond leaving the car door area, you will be asked to park in the lot.

● Dismissal

- All camp groups will be dismissed outside the backdoors of their classroom or gymnasium to their designated pick-up person. Pick-up people will be directed through the back gate to the classroom for pick-up.
- Rising 5th-8th graders with a signed Unaccompanied Dismissal form in the Document Center may leave the building independently.

- Medication, epipens, etc. (if applicable)

 - Inhaler (if necessary)

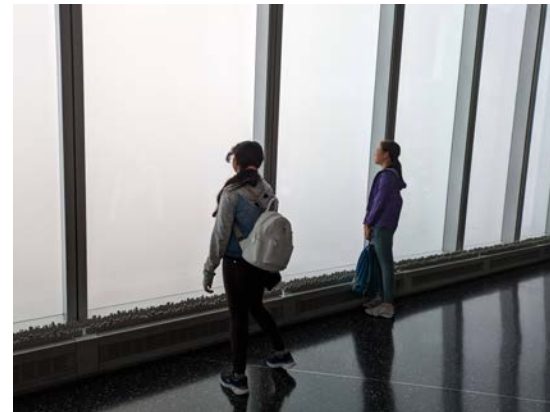


Weather



Camp Administration monitor weather conditions regularly and frequently

- Newport Swim and Fitness Center closes for 30 minutes after each lightning strike within a 10 mile radius
- Outdoor activities are canceled in the event of severe rain
- Outdoor activities will be adjusted in the event of extreme heat/humidity
- Air quality for a sustained period of time
 - <100 - Normal operations
 - 100-150 - considerations to be made including limiting time outside
 - 150+ - Alternative indoor activities are scheduled
- Every attempt will be made to reschedule or re-route field trips affected by weather, however, no refunds will be issued if cancelled outright.

Campers who miss the bus on field trip days are not able to stay at camp as they do not have a group to stay with
- **Can I add more weeks to my child's summer camp registration?**
 - Registration remains open all summer until one week prior to each camp week.
- **Do you have any camps offered after August 14?**
 - No. The final weeks of a August are used by our facilities team to prepare our buildings for the start of the school
- **Do you have an app for Summer Camp at Stevens?**
 - No. We use Vidigami photo sharing and the UltraCamp portal for all formal communication.
- **My camper has a friend coming to camp. Can they be together?**
 - The best way to ensure your camper is with their friend is if you have signed up for the same program and you fill out the "Camper Grouping Request Form" in the Document Center of UltraCamp.
- **Does my camper need to be potty trained?**
 - Yes. Fully toilet-trained children must be able to do the following without adult assistance and minimal adult prompting:
 - Be accident-free in regular underwear (i.e., not training pants or disposable pull-ups) for a two week daytime period
 - Recognize and able to tell a teacher in words that they must use the bathroom before they have to go
 - Hold their bathroom need until they can get to the bathroom from a classroom or the playground
 - Able to get on and off the toilet mostly independently
 - Pull down/up their pants/underwear or lift dress/skirt (we can help with difficult snaps or buttons if needed)
 - Wipe themselves after using the bathroom
 - Flush the toilet
 - Wash/dry their hands
