

Camp Y.I. is a CLOSED TOE shoe environment. We don't allow sandals with open toes at main camp, or at any of our programming areas.

With our terrain in mind, we suggest tennis or hiking shoes or boots that may get wet and dirty.

Sandals and flip-flops are allowed for shower use only. Water shoes allowed on lake activities.

Slip & Fall hazard, we do not allow Crocs on camp.
