



PACKING LIST

The climate in Estes Park is quite dry with very low humidity necessitating lip balm, lotion, and sunscreen. Cheley Camps is an elevation of 8,200 feet in the Rocky Mountains where weather can vary greatly throughout the day. Mornings and evening can be chilly requiring a sweatshirt or a fleece and days can be in the 80s or low 90s.

Clothing at camp is best kept simple and inexpensive. On Sunday, we spruce up a bit for final banquet. Please label clothes with your camper's name.

Returning staff – Remember to pack your Blue Kerchiefs

- Warm jacket
- Windbreaker or light jacket
- Rain Jacket
- Rain Pants-if you have them
- Sweatshirt or Hoody
- Gloves
- Warm Hat
- Shirts-long and short sleeved – 3 of each
- Jeans/Belt
- Shorts
- Winter weight pajamas
- Socks
- Underwear
- Swimsuit
- Towel and wash cloth
- Tennis/Running shoes
- Hiking Boots or Sturdy Shoes—if you have them
- Cowboy Boots
- Laundry Bag (or old pillow case)
- Toilet articles (toothbrush, toothpaste, comb, brush, shampoo, soap, chapstick, Kleenex, etc.)
- Prescription Medications
- Sleeping Bag/Blanket—**Bedding is provided, this is optional.**

Additional, optional Items:

- Camera
- Journal
- Spending money...Camp store, Snacks in town
- Musical Instrument
- Costumes for Talent Show

ITEMS TO BE LEFT AT HOME

We live in the moment and try to be present the whole time at camp. The campers are not allowed to have the following items at camp. If the campers choose to bring these items for the airplane and bus ride, they turn it in the first day and the items are returned right before they board the bus.

As a staff person, we understand that you need to bring some of these items to use out of the sight of the campers. We keep these items in a counselor cabin to be used when your campers have coverage from another adult.

- Laptops
- Cell Phones
- I-Pad and tablets
- I-Pod or MP3
- Snacks – We do have an opportunity to buy extra snacks in town the morning before the campers arrive. These will be stored in a locked cabin to prevent wildlife from getting into the food.

Camp is about creating a safe environment for everyone. **Alcohol, tobacco, and street drugs are not permitted on Cheley property. This policy is enforced. If you feel you cannot comply with this policy, please have a conversation with Trudy and reconsider your decision to attend camp until a time when you can.** We ask the same of the campers.
