



PACKING LIST

The climate in Estes Park is quite dry with very low humidity necessitating lip balm, lotion, and sunscreen. Cheley Camps is an elevation of 8,200 feet in the Rocky Mountains where weather can vary greatly throughout the day. Mornings and evening can be chilly requiring a sweatshirt or a fleece and days can be in the 80s or low 90s.

Clothing at camp is best kept simple and inexpensive. On Sunday, we spruce up a bit for final banquet. Please label clothes with your camper's name.

- Warm jacket
- Windbreaker or light jacket
- Rain Jacket/Poncho
- Rain Pants-if you have them
- Sweatshirt or Hoody
- Gloves
- Warm Hat
- Shirts-long and short sleeved – 3 of each
- Jeans/Belt- at least 2 pairs
- Shorts
- Winter weight pajamas
- Socks-7 pairs
- Underwear-7 pair
- Swimsuit
- Towel and wash cloth
- Tennis/Running shoes
- Hiking Boots or Sturdy Shoes—if you have them
- Laundry Bag (or old pillow case)
- Toilet articles (toothbrush, toothpaste, comb, brush, shampoo, soap, chapstick, Kleenex, etc.)
- Prescription Medications
- Sleeping Bag/Blanket—Bedding is provided, this is optional.

Optional Items:

- Camera – You need another option than your phone. Phones are turned in upon arrival to camp.
- Fishing pole/Musical instrument
- Journal and/or stationery...pre-addressed, stamped envelopes
- Small amount of spending money...Camp store, airport snacks
