Health and Safety at Camp

Health

All campers must fill out a health form. All medications, including over-the-counter medications, must be turned in to the adult chaperone, or GEV staff, upon arrival at camp. All medications must be in the original packaging and clearly marked with your child's name and dosage instructions.

Safety Procedures

We are an ACA accredited camp and follow all safety procedures. We have staff onsite trained in CPR and first aid, and in the case of a medical emergency there is hospital nearby and parents will be contacted. In the event of a severe weather emergency Good Earth Village has secure storm shelters and storm radios. Safety is always a priority at Good Earth Village.

What NOT to Bring & GEV Policy

You will not need the following items, which would detract from your experience at camp and that of other campers. We recommend that you not bring expensive personal items, clothing or jewelry. We also ask that you don't bring electronic devices (phones, smart watches, gaming systems, etc.), money, candy, soda, or food.

No Cell Phones. One of the many valuable benefits of a camp experience is uninterrupted time spent away from our normal routine. Leave phones at home and fully experience your time here at Good Earth Village.

Drugs, alcohol, weapons, fireworks, etc. Good Earth Village is a drug and weapon-free environment. In the event that a camper brings drugs, alcohol, weapons, or explosives to camp, parents will be contacted.

Good Earth Village reserves the right to store camper's contraband items that may not be appropriate for their stay. Items will be returned at the end of the retreat. Campers that are found not upholding Good Earth Village values and expectations will be sent home early.
