WHAT IS IT?

Fun, laughter, and adventure. That's the recipe for time well spent with family. This fall, provide your family with lifelong memories, and join us for a weekend spent exploring faith and the outdoors.

WHO IS IT FOR?

The Becoming an Outdoors Family Campout program is for families who are new to camping and the outdoors. With the expert guidance of our instructors, we will teach you how to fish, camp, kayak, and cook outdoors, in a relaxed and safe environment.

WHEN & WHERE IS IT?

The campout is September 23 & 24. It takes place at Carol Joy Holling Camp, west of Mahoney State Park, at 27416 Ranch Road, Ashland, NE 68003. We will provide all food, equipment, and program materials. You'll choose lodging in either rustic cabins (\$175/cabin) or tent camping (\$150/campsite) for your stay.



HOW DO I REGISTER?

Head to CJHCenter.org/OutdoorFamily to register using CJH's registration software, UltraCamp. If you are new to UltraCamp, you will need to create an account. ACTIVITIES

OUTDOOR COOKING

KAYAKING

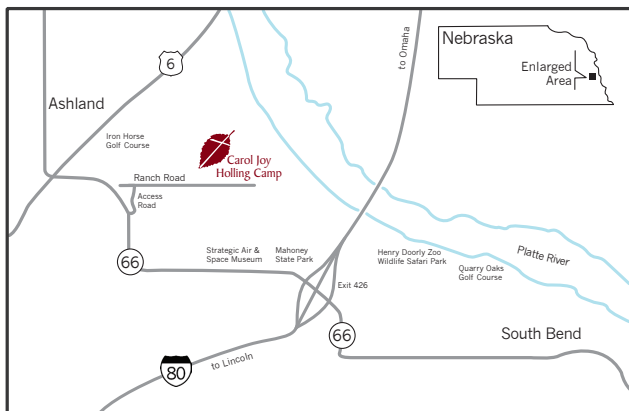
After this workshop, you will practice your newfound knowledge on safe and quiet waters.

AQUATIC ECOLOGY

Learn about life in the water. Collect samples of aquatic animals and plants under the direction of a Master Naturalist.

ARCHERY AND SHOOTING SPORTS

Learn about form, technique, and basic archery terminology, and then enjoy taking aim at various 3-D targets. Instructors will train you on fire-arm safety for an opportunity to shoot a pellet gun and for those 10 and older try your hand at trapshooting.



Driving Directions

- Carol Joy Holling is located at the end of Ranch Road off Highway 66 between Interstate 80 and Ashland.
- If you are coming on I-80, take Exit 426. Turn toward Ashland and go 2.5 miles past Mahoney State Park to the Ranch Road access road.
- If you are coming from north of Ashland on Highway 66, come through Ashland, cross Highway 6, and continue 1.25 miles, then turn onto the Ranch Road access road.
- Watch for the "Carol Joy Holling Center" directional sign.
