We will let you know daily themes and what to wear before camp.

(see instructions on registering below). Day Camp depends on staff to help campers develop lifelong friendship skills, learn teamwork, have fun, experience the natural world, and stay safe! It is an opportunity for our volunteers to develop additional skills that help them continue their education, become even better parents, and increase job skills, and to also have fun, too!

Times: Day camp starts for staff at **9:00 a.m.** every day, and goes until the last camper is picked up and the site is clean and the gear is packed and stored (**usually around 4 p.m.**) Permission to come late or leave early is granted on a case-by-case basis. If you are responsible for a family member or neighbor who is a camper, they may come at the same time with you. We will have a plan for their care while we are getting ready for the day, and after camp.

Training: Training is <u>required</u> for ALL staff, both new and returning in order to conduct safe, high quality programs, in compliance with American Camp Association (ACA) standards of accreditation. Training time is also included in the total service hours you receive as a volunteer.

You are required to attend 2 training sessions:

- 1. One **Off-site training** (an **indoor training** that covers child development, safety, policies and procedures). You are expected to read and learn the contents of the **Staff Manual** you receive there.
 - <u>AND</u>
- 2. **On-site training** at Hans Jensen (outdoors rain or shine, practice safety drills, learn the park, and plan with your work team).
