

## What to Bring to Overnight Camp

ALL items must be labeled with camper's name, including their water bottle. Please feel free to turn this list in to cabin staff. We encourage campers to bring items which promote independence, adaptability and assist in providing a quality stay.

Check IN is from 3:00-5:00 pm and check OUT is from 10:00-11:00 am.
