We are run by the Lake Geneva Fresh Air association and are accredited by the American Camp Association. We exist to provide educational and recreational fresh air experiences to those children who could otherwise not afford to attend camp. We focus all camp programming around our three values: Respect, Responsibility and Relationships.

• Summer Camp

Our summer camp program provides children entering 2nd through 6th grade with a positive fresh air camp experience. Our programming helps campers foster life skills as they participate in traditional camp activities such as hiking, swimming, boating, arts and crafts, archery, skits, games, outdoor education and much more! While participating in these activities campers gain confidence, responsibility, communication skills, positive sportsmanship, and respect for self, others, and their environment.

• Paying For Camp

Holiday Home Camp believes that every child deserves a fresh air camp experience.

Therefore, NO child will be turned away due to the inability to pay. We provide several unique scholarships which your camper may be eligible for. Upon receiving your camper paperwork, the Camp Registrar will align your campers with the proper scholarship.



- **Registration Fees** vary based on scholarships with the maximum being \$25. Registration fees are non refundable and are due prior to your campers session. The Camp Registrar will notify you of your registration fee amount. Payment

Day Camp Sessions

SOME OF THE AMAZING ADVENTURES ARE:

Rainbow Tag—The campers and staff will be on happy hill and the staff will be designated a color of paint. The children must run around, find each staff member who will then mark on their arm with paint. The person who is 'it' we call them rain. They will be running around with a sponge and when they tag someone, they wipe all of the paint off of their arm. The goal is to get all the colors in the game on your arm.

Theme/Dress Up Days—

- The Amazing Race: Wear your best tourist outfit or survivor outfit and let's explore! Travel around the globe this summer day as we discover new arts and crafts, games, and more from all over the world. A fun and friendly completion to learn new cultures within your super group
- Cartoon Creations— Dress up as your favorite character from Disney, Marvel, DC, or Nickelodeon as we travel to each television station. A day full of superhero scavenger hunts, Moana water games, and so much more!

• Camp Store Money

All campers will get a chance to visit our camp store! We recommend that you send between \$5 and \$20 with your camper to camp. Camp Store money will be collected for safekeeping by camp staff at drop off. **Left over camp store money will be donated to the camp scholarship fund.**

• Discipline Problems

We work with each camper to promote their success at camp. To promote a good camp experience, any camper whose behavior is, in the judgment of leadership, unruly, will have their guardians notified and may be sent home in extreme cases. In the event that a camper is sent home, **it is the parents/guardians responsibility to pick the camper up from camp property within 4 hours of notification.** Failure to do so could lead to the child being turned over to protective or social services.

• Healthcare

All Holiday Home staff are certified in First Aid and CPR. We have an on-call Registered Nurse and Doctor. There is no charge for minor medical attention on camp property. In the event of serious illness or injury, parents/guardians will be notified immediately and charges will be made to the parents/guardians or to the insurance carrier.

- **Campers who take medication** will turn all medication in to HHC staff at the time of drop off. All medication must be listed on the authorization to administer meds form and in the original bottle with the child's name on it. The Day Camp Director will administer the medication as it is listed on the bottle. If a camper arrives at camp without their proper medication, they may be sent home.
