Paying for Camp

We believe that every child deserves a fresh air camp experience. Therefore, <u>NO</u> child will be turned away due to the inability to pay. Registration fees vary based on scholarships with the maximum being **\$50**. This fee is nonrefundable and is due prior to your camp arrival. You will be notified of your registration fee amount.

Camp Store Money

All campers get a chance to visit our camp store! We recommend sending your camper with between \$5 and \$30. Camp Store money will be collected for safekeeping by camp staff at drop-off. Leftover camp store money will be donated to the camp scholarship fund.

If your camper is struggling at camp...

We work with each camper to promote success at camp. To ensure a good camp experience for all, any camper whose behavior is considered unruly by leadership staff will have their guardians notified and may be sent home in extreme cases. If a camper is sent home, it is the parents/guardian's responsibility to pick up from camp property within 4 hours of notification. Failure to do so could result in the Camp Director contacting social services.

Healthcare

All HHC staff are certified in First Aid and CPR. We have a full-time Health Care Coordinator and an on-call Registered Nurse and Doctor. There is no charge for minor medical attention on camp property. In the event of severe illness or injury, parents/guardians will be notified immediately and insurance information will be passed on to the medical facility. Campers who take medication will turn them all in to HHC staff at the time of drop off. All meds must be listed during the registration process and arrive in original bottles with the child's name on. The Health Care Coordinator will administer medication as it is listed on the bottle. If a camper arrives at camp without proper medication, they may be sent home.
