# Camp Basics



## **DATE & TIMES**



Gan Israel is a six week program starting the end of June through the first part of August.

In order for your child to fully benefit from the scope of available programs, we strongly encourage his/her participation in at least a two-week session or the full sixweek session.

Monday through Friday camp starts at 9:00 am and ends at 4:00

Extended early and late care begins at 8:00 am and ends at 5:30 pm.

The weekly fee is \$15 for morning care only or \$25 for both, per child.

There is no late care offered on Fridays.

## **MORNING DROP-OFF** PROCEDURE:

An adult must personally sign in vour child at morning drop-off.

#### **ARRIVAL TO CAMP**

Camp begins every day promptly, at 9:00am. Be sure to drop-off your child between 8:45am-9:00am, as on some days we will be leaving camp grounds

right away.



Transportation is available via vellow school bus.

Drop-off and pick up will be at the main camp entrance.

End of day pick-up begins at 3:45 pm and ends at 4:00 pm.

Please be prompt in picking up vour child.

## **END OF DAY PICK-UP** PROCEDURE:

To ensure safe and smooth pick-up, we have implemented a pick-up system. When you arrive at camp, the staff member will announce your arrival to the camp indoors and your child will be brought to the front. You will then sign out your child to take him/her home.

## **CHANGE OF YOUR DISMISSAL PLANS**



If your child's end of ..... the day arrangement is different from normal, a parent must email the camp secretary.

Do not leave a phone message. This includes change in car-pool arrangements, play dates, etc. Please avoid calling camp during the day with changes, unless it is a true emergency. If both parents are out of town, camp must be informed. Any person picking up your child must be on the authorized pick-up list. Otherwise an email must be sent.

### **DRESS CODE**

**Footwear:** For safety, children must wear appropriate shoes, no slides or flip-flops allowed. Crocs are not appropriate for athletic activities.

## **Clothing:**

Clothes should be comfortable. washable and appropriate for camp activities.

**Camp wear:** It is mandatory that campers wear a CGI t-shirt & bracelet during camp. One t-shirt is included for each camper in camp package. Additional camp shirts are available for purchase at \$5 each.

**Hats:** Campers must bring a camp sunhat cap each day to protect them from the sun.

## **SWIMMING INFO**

Swimming will be offered every day of the week except trip day. On swimming days, please be sure to send your child to camp with a bathing suit, bathing cap and towel as well water shoes, sunscreen or additional water equipment required by your child (goggles etc.).

#### **HOT LUNCH**

Includes hot nutritious nut-free lunch or sandwiches and two snacks a day. A complete printable menu is available on our website.

Parents who choose to send a lunch with their child, please ensure it is Kosher, nut- free and in a recyclable bag. We request that no meat be sent to camp. Dairy lunch is permitted provided that the camp is not serving meat that day.

## TYPICAL CAMP DAY

9:00am: Campers proceed to their group meeting areas. Attendance is taken at lineup with calisthenics, and the fun is ready to begin.

9:15am: Groups proceed to the first of their eight activities. The schedule is varied throughout each day combining sports and fun activities.

**Lunch**: During lunch you can feel the camp spirit with singing in the air

Snack: In the morning and before your child leaves Gan Israel for the day, they are given delicious and nutritious snacks (those who have signed up for lunch & snacks).

**Dismissal**: The last period ends at 3:45 P.M. and all groups proceed to their meeting areas. They receive snacks, end of the day announcements and dismissed to their buses which leave camp at 4:00 P.M.
