## ARRIVAL:

**REGISTRATION** and drop off for camps starting on Sunday is at 3:00 p.m. in Shalom. Closing campfire and **pick-up** will be Tuesday at 6:30 p.m.

**REGISTRATION** and drop off for camps starting on Wednesday is at 9:30 a.m. in Shalom. Closing campfire and **pick-up** will be Friday at 11:00 a.m.

Where do I check in? Check-in is at the Luther Point Retreat Center (the first right as you are coming into camp.)

What will happen when I get there? There will be counselors to greet you and show you where to park. You will need to check-in with your grandchild. Then you will be assigned a room and a counselor.

Do I need to check in at registration even if I have already paid? Yes, that is how we know who is here and who isn't.

### **HEALTH AND SAFETY ANSWERS:**

Does the child need a physical by a physician? We recommend one every two years but it is not required.

What do I do with the Health History Form


you sent me? Have the legal guardian/parent of the child you are bringing fill it out and sign it. Luther Point cannot allow any child to stay at camp without his or her legal parent/guardian unless a current health history form has been filled out and signed by his or her legal guardian/parent.

When does Luther Point need the Health

Form? Either mail it two weeks before your start date or bring the signed form with you to camp at check-in time.

Will we be safe? The staff is highly trained. There are Emergency Responders available 24 hours a day no matter where you or your grandchild are. We have an AED at camp. A doctor is available on call. There are trained lifeguards at the beach and trained counselors at the recreation areas.

What about insurance? Each camper is covered primarily by their own insurance and secondarily by Luther Point's Accident Insurance Policy. If you need to have a health form for the child you are bringing, you must include a copy of his or her insurance and pharmacy cards.





# MISC QUESTIONS:

Can we bring a bicycle? Yes. Many people bring non-motorized bicycles. Be sure to bring safety helmets, knee and elbow pads as well. (motorized are not allowed)

Will I be able to have a nap? Yes, the counselor that is assigned to you can play with your grandchild when you want to rest.

What if I have a food allergy? Let us know and we will accommodate you to the best of our ability.

Where will we be staying? There are 12 rooms in the Luther Point Retreat Center. Each of the rooms has its own bathroom/shower. If we have more than 12 sets of grand-parent/children, then you will be housed in Luther Lodge or a remodeled family cabin which are both very accommodating.

Can I bring bedding instead of a sleeping bag? Yes. Each room in the Retreat Center has a double bed and some twin beds. You can pick which bed you would like and which one your grandchild will use.

Do I need to bring towels, washcloths and soap?

# OTHER MISC QUESTIONS:

Can I bring my guitar? Yes, please bring a musical instrument and share your talents with us.

What if I can't sing? God said make a joyful noise not a pretty noise. No one will notice. Really!

What if I don't know the songs? The counselors will teach them to you.

Can I bring my fishing pole? Yes, but don't forget your Wisconsin license. The DNR does patrol the lake.

**What is a counselor?** An enthusiastic, young college-aged person that loves people and the Lord. They are here to help you feel welcomed!

What kind of food is served? There are large break-fasts. There is a salad bar at lunch and supper as well as a main course. It is very good food.

### MONEY ANSWERS:

### Can I get my deposit refunded?

The required deposit of \$65 is non-refundable and non-transferable after May 1. If cancellation occurs prior to May 1, the deposit will be refunded less a \$15 processing fee.

When is the rest of my payment due?

Mail the final payment at least two weeks in advance of your start date or bring it with you to check-in.

What if my friend or I can't afford to come to Luther Point? If you need a campership, please write us a note or call us. No one is turned away from Luther Point because of inability to pay. The actual cost for each person to come to camp is more than \$470 a week. The registration fee does not cover the full cost. We are very grateful to all the people who make it possible for kids and families to come to camp through their generous financial gifts.

When is the camp store open? At check-in and departure times. Also, once in the afternoon and once in the evening while you are here. A charge account will be set up for you and your family and you can pay on Friday when you leave.

How do I pay for crafts? A charge account will be set up for you and your family and you can pay on Friday when you leave. Crafts range from 25 cents to \$5.

Can we use a credit card? Yes, we accept Master-Card and Visa.
