## **Food Service**

We work with the WI State Health Inspector and the CDC to make sure we follow all food service guidelines.

**Canteen/Camp Store**

During the stay you and your family can buy snacks in the Canteen and purchase crafts to work on. Snacks and crafts range from 50 cents to \$5.00. You'll have access in the afternoon and evening times for snacks. Other camp merchandise include shirts and sweatshirts ranging in price from \$15-\$40.
