

Health Form Checklist for 2021 FCS Summer Camp

We ask that parents submit their camper's required forms by **Friday, May 21, 2021**, in order for camp staff to process each form. If registering after May 21, the deadline for submission of required camper health forms is **two weeks** before the start of your child's first camp session. These forms are required by state guidelines, and any delay in submitting these forms will result in possible removal from the camp registration.

Required for ALL campers (including currently enrolled FCS students)

- ☑ Camper Health History (Form A, 2-pages)
- ☑ FCS Medication and Health Policy (Form B, 2-pages)

Fill in your child's information, **sign**, **and date**. Your signature indicates that you have read and understood the FCS Medication Policy.

- ☑ Emergency Contact & Medical Treatment Authorization (Form C, 1-page)
- ☑ Consent for Sunscreen/Repellent Form (Form D, 1-page)
- ☑ Authorization for Pick-Up (See Ultracamp > My Account > Pickup Authorization)
- ☑ Negative COVID-19 PCR Test within 3 days before the first camp, every other week afterward, after skipping 1+ weeks, AND in the event of returning from COVID-19 related guarantine or travel.

Required for SOME campers

Read descriptions to determine which forms apply to your child's needs. *Note: Currently enrolled FCS students with medication on file can roll over the following applicable forms. Please upload them here as the summer camp database is separate from the school year database.

☑ Medication Order (Form G, 1-page)

A separate form must be **completed by the prescriber** for each *emergency* and/or *routinely administered* medication (prescription, over-the-counter, homeopathic, or herbal) that will be needed by the student while at camp.

- ☑ Two signatures are required (the prescriber and the parent/guardian)
- ☑ Each different medication requires its own separate Medication Order

☑ EpiPen – Allergy Action Plan (Form H, 1-page)

Required for any camper who may require an EpiPen. The form must be completed and signed by a physician and signed by a parent/guardian

☑ Refer to FCS Medication and Health Policy for labeling instructions for EpiPens.

☑ Inhaler – Physician's Authorization (Form I, 1-page)

Required for any camper who may require an inhaler. The top portion must be completed, **in addition to the above**Medication Order, and signed by a physician and signed by a parent.

☑ Refer to FCS Medication and Health Policy for labeling instructions for inhalers.

☑ Immunization Certificate – DHMH 896 (Form J. 2-pages)

Required for any camper who resides outside the United States, a United States territory, or the District of Columbia.
