

COVID-19 Testing

PM Pediatrics is delighted to offer SARS-CoV2 PCR testing to help you attend this summer's camps safely!

HOW DOES THE TESTING WORK?

PM Pediatrics has created a near-touchless process where the screening/registration is completed prior to the testing visit, to make the process in-and-out for your testing appointment. The preferred testing windows at our Greenbelt location each Thursday between 1pm and 8pm. We use the most precise molecular PCR test which generally takes 1-3 days to result. The swab is an anterior nasal swab and is not a nasopharyngeal (uncomfortable) swab.

Step 1: Schedule a 'Virtual Visit' [Monday – Wednesday]

- <https://pmpediatrics.com/pmpanywhere/> (also available as an Apple or Android app – search for PM Pediatrics Anywhere)
- There should be no co-pay required.
- This is offered from 8am-Midnight every day. The patient (child or adult) needs to be present.
- A physician or nurse practitioner will ask some specific questions, answer any concerns, and then will book an appointment for your COVID-PCR-TEST and you will receive an email and text confirmation.
- Please complete this step by Wednesday at 8pm for your Thursday test.

Step 2: Upload documents [one day prior to your testing appointment]

- After receiving your appointment confirmation, click the link in the message to attach documents.
- The software (SOLV) will ask you to take a photograph of your insurance card and ID, and then sign an online consent. These tasks need to be completed before midnight the day prior to your testing day.

Step 3: Go to PM Pediatrics in Greenbelt for your appointment as scheduled.

- When you arrive, stay in your car and reply to your text confirmation that you have arrived. You will be instructed when to come inside.

Step 4: After the test

- You will receive an email notification when your test has resulted. Clicking a link in the email will take you to your patient portal where you can view/print the lab result.
- If you or your child has a positive test, we will call you as will the local Department of Health.

PM Pediatrics accepts almost every private and public health insurance plan. Generally, insurance companies have covered all costs associated with COVID-19 screening, specimen collection, and lab processing. But every insurance carrier has their own policy so please check with your insurance plan if you have concerns about your coverage or to see if a deductible might apply.
