Open to all guests, the Nature Center features interactive nature displays, live animals, & a bird-watching window.


Puzzles and Games

The Retreat Center Library and Meeting Areas contain puzzles and board games for children and adults. All guests are invited to use the puzzles & games.


Activities Center/Gym
