



Camp Hawkeye

Notes on Camp Transportation

Location of meeting places:

The meeting locations for transportation to & from camp include:

- The first rest area, CT Welcome Center, on Merritt Parkway North (Route 15)
- Logan Airport – Terminal E International Arrivals – Ground Transportation

Safety Procedures:

1. Only leave your child(ren) with official Hawkeye staff!

Camp staff will ALWAYS be wearing Camp Hawkeye staff t-shirts that have the “Camp Hawkeye Community” with the logo on the front and “STAFF” in block letters on the back. The names of Staff doing pick up and drop off will be communicated to you ahead of time. If you ever have any questions ask to see identification and check in with the camp office 603-253-3088.

2. Never leave your child to wait for the van alone!

3. Have your child(ren) prepared for the drive with a full water bottle and some snacks.

4. Note that all camp rules apply on and during camp transportation. Review the Camper Code of Conduct as necessary

What if the van is late?

You will receive a call from the camp office or vehicle navigator if there has been a delay and the van will be late. Keep your phone with you and make sure to answer it.

How will I know if my child arrived safely?

You will receive a call or email from the camp office letting you know that your child arrived safely at camp soon after they do. If you think they should have arrived already please do not hesitate to call the camp office 603-253-3088. Keep your phone with you and turned on.

Safety Rules for the Van:

Hawkeye vehicles are not allowed to exceed the speed limit and may take longer than you would in your personal vehicle to get some place.

Please prep your child for cooperative and positive behavior in the van. Seatbelts are required and good behavior is necessary to participate in camp transportation.

What to do if you get lost:

If you do get lost please call the office at 603-253-3088. We will be there to assist you in getting to the meeting point.
