What You Need to Do Before Arrival

- Make an appointment if your camper needs a physical examination (current within 12 months of camp attendance)
- **Read** "*Parent Information Planner*" (in the document center of your account at UltraCamp)
- Complete "*Personal and Confidential*" form (online form in the document center of your account at UltraCamp)
- Complete and return the Health Examination Form - must be completed by a physician (download it from UltraCamp in Document Center and send completed forms back to the camp or you can upload it into your UltraCamp account)
- Complete the Health History Form (online form on UltraCamp in Document Center)
- *Order Farwell Clothing (totally optional)...coming soon*
- check with camp before purchasing airline ticket; contact Marley regarding bus transportation from NYC and Boston.
- ship luggage before arrival if on a domestic flight
