



**Museum and NAS Gate Access and Protocols:**

By rule, All Non - D.O.D personnel are required to use the West Gate NAS entrance, located at 1878 South Blue Angels Parkway, Pensacola, FL. 32507. If you possess a DOD or Military ID, you are permitted to access the Base through the East Gate, located at 1420 Duncan Rd. Pensacola, FL 32508. **Most GPS devices will route the driver to the restricted-access, East Gate; DO NOT FOLLOW this GPS route unless you hold a DOD or Military ID.** Please see page 2 for a map detailing the route to the Museum.

**Drop Off Location:**

**1750 Radford Blvd. Pensacola, Fl. 32508.** This location is the Naval Aviation Museum. From the Museum's main parking lot, you may access a service road that runs along the Museum's South Side of the building, where the Cubi Cafe' is located. Please look for Summer Camp signs offering directions to this location. The Cubi Cafe' is our official drop off point. Drop off time is between 0845 and 0900. Please look for one of our Summer Camp Staffers before departing the Museum's premisses.

**Pick Up Location:**

The pick up location is the Museum's Main Front Entrance, located along the West-South-West side of the building. The Main Museum Entrance is identifiable by a F14 Tomcat, on display outside, just in front of the Museum's large awning. Please feel free to pull up under this awning, and wait for your camper(s) to be released. Long lines of vehicles tend to bottle-neck at this location. Please be patient!

**Important daily notes!**

**Campers will be responsible for bringing their own lunch, drink, and snack.**

**Monday:** Please introduce yourself to one of our teachers!

**Tuesday or Wednesday:** Blue Angels Practice \*If available\* **Please wear light clothes (and your summer camp t-shirt)** and bring a hat or sun glasses. \*Sun screen, water, and ear protection are made available for all campers.

**Thursday: Please arrive by 0845,** in order to catch our 0900 Trolley Tour.

**Friday AM:** Rocket Launch at Parade Field, located on NAS Pensacola. \*Rocket Launch is NOT available to parents. Please wear light clothes and bring a hat or sun glasses.

**Friday PM:** Graduation Ceremony, 1400. **Parents are invited to attend the graduation ceremony,** located in the Museums' "Little Theater," located next to the Cubi Cafe'.

## Flight Adventure Deck Summer Camp

Camp sessions begin at 9:00 a.m. (Monday through Friday) and end at 3:00 p.m. **Please be on time.**

The parent/guardian will be responsible for the transportation of the Camper to and from the Museum. Please notify FAD Summer Camp Staff if you choose to car pool.

New NAS security policies mandate that **all non-Department of Defense personnel use the West Access Gate, located at 1878 South Blue Angel Parkway**, for base accessibility.

**Drop-off location is the Cubi Point Cafe'**, located on the South side of the Museum. Please be on the lookout for FADSC staff and do not leave your camper unattended.

**Pick Up location will be the Museum's Front Entrance.** Be on the lookout for FASDC staff. You may park in the main parking lot or you are welcome to pull your vehicle up to the front awning and pick your camper up. Please have a photo ID available when picking your camper(s) up.

**Campers will be responsible for bringing their own lunch, drink, and snack.**

The Campers will be based at the National Naval Aviation Museum located at 1750 Radford Blvd. At various times the classes will be at other locations on base for special activities. **In case of an emergency, your child may be reached by contacting the FADSC staff at 850-453-2389. Please identify yourself as a parent of a FAD Summer Camper.**

**Dress Code:** Each day your child attends FADSC, be sure he/she is wearing comfortable clothing (Tee-shirt and shorts) and appropriate foot ware. **No crocs or open-toed shoes.** Children may bring cameras. However, FADSC assumes no responsibility for personal items the Camper may bring. \*Ear protection and sunscreen provided on Blue Angel days.

**Medical** - Any medial concerns may be addressed by calling Jonathan Runge at (850) 308-8957.

**Graduation** will be held at 2PM on Fridays, in the Museum's Little Theater; Parents are invited.

If a Camper becomes disruptive or places himself/herself or any other Camper in a situation that might cause harm to anyone, the Camper's parent/guardian will be contacted by a member of the FADSC staff and asked to come to the National Naval Aviation Museum and pick up the Camper immediately.

### Flight Adventure Deck Summer Camp

PENSACOLA, FLA.— All unescorted visitors to the National Naval Aviation Museum, Pensacola Lighthouse, and Fort Barrancas, who do not possess valid DoD identification, will be required to enter Naval Air Station (NAS) Pensacola via the West gate (Blue Angel Parkway).
