

CAMP Runs M-F from 8:00 – 1:00

Museum and NAS Gate Access and Protocols:

If you possess a DOD or Military ID, you are permitted to access the Base through the East & West Gates, East gate is located at 1420 Duncan Road. Pensacola, FL 32508. Please see page 2 for a map detailing the route to the Museum.

Drop Off Location:

1750 Radford Blvd. Pensacola, Fl. 32508. This location is the Naval Aviation Museum (<u>covered awning</u> <u>of the CUBI BAR CAFÉ attached to the Museum</u>). From the Museum's main parking lot, you may access a service road that runs along the Museum's South Side of the building, where the <u>drop off will be at the</u> <u>picnic tables</u>, exterior of Cubi Café/ On side road boarding Cubi/Museum. Please look for posted day camp signs offering directions to this location. The Cubi Cafe' awning is our official drop off point. Drop off time is 8:00 and pick-up is 1:00. Please check-in your camper with one of our STARBASE Staff, this 'drop off area' is a keep moving zone but if you need to park there is an adjacent lot. The actual camp will take place at STARBASE the 2nd Deck of the National Flight Academy (1 Fetterman Way).

Pick Up Location:

The pick-up location will be the same as drop off, unless raining in which we will be under the Cubi Bar Café side-walk awning. **Pick-up will be at 1:00 sharp**.

Lunch & Snack: You will need to pack your <u>camper a lunch, and snack daily</u>. Please <u>no peanut products</u>. We encourage you to send a water bottle with your child every day.

Lunch Visitation: If you would like to join your camper during their lunch break, we would love to have you. You may park at the gravel lot across from the front entrance of NFA. We will meet you in the lobby 5 minutes prior to lunch time & escort you to your camper's class space. Lunch Schedule times will be given out on Monday at drop off.

Dress Attire: Your camper will be provided with a tee-shirt on their first day of camp. Children may wear shorts or pants. Many activities will be outdoors great, so shorts and tee-shirts are perfect. Your Camper <u>MUST wear close toed shoes.</u> Campers may bring cameras & phones but will be asked to not have them out during activities. If your child attends a Blue Angel Practice we encourage you to pack sunscreen – hats, etc.. to outfit your child for the heat of the flight line (& water bottle)

Monday: Check-In! We are happy your camper is with us! 🐵

Tuesday or Wednesday: Blue Angels Practice *If available* Please wear light clothes (and your summer camp t-shirt) and bring a hat or sunglasses. ***Families please apply sunscreen at home**. Water & ear protection will be made available for campers.

Friday Morning: You will be invited to come out and watch your child participate in a STEM project <u>like</u> <u>rocket launch or CO-2 Car races or some similar activity</u>! More information will be sent out on your campers' special STEM project launch & times for you to attend. If will likely be first thing in the morning at drop off.


During the summer camp week, our staffers will be documenting our activities and make all photos available to parents, for download, free of charge, via your <u>UltraCamp.com</u> account.
