- To balance camp standards and expectations with flexibility to create a safe environment while seizing opportunities to create unique experiences.
- To manage stress and use positive techniques for reducing stress. To respond quickly and effectively to situations, including emergencies.

- Help train, oversee and evaluation CIT's (Counselors in training)
- Prepare, serve, and clean up daily meals
- Ensure safe and sanitary operations in the kitchen
