Daily Schedule - Knowlton Campus* - 990 62nd Ave NE

Before camp start time, campers wait in the Knowlton Cafe (*see drop-off procedures*). Supervision is NOT available for campers outside the designated drop off/pick up and camp times.

- Morning camper drop-off is **no earlier than 8:30 a.m.**; campers must be **picked up by 12:15 p.m.**

- Afternoon camper drop-off is no earlier than 12:45 p.m.; campers must be picked up by 4:15 p.m.

Drop-Off Procedures (8:30 a.m. - 8:55 a.m. | 12:45 p.m. - 1:00 p.m.)

- Enter through the entrance off 62nd Avenue NE (Knowlton Campus Camps).
- Adhere to one-way traffic signs and follow the traffic flow (see traffic map below).
- Please do NOT drop off early/before camp drop-off times: 8:30 a.m. morning camps | 12:45 p.m. afternoon camps; scheduled adult supervision is unavailable before drop-off.
- Drop off at the front steps to ensure student safety; do not park or drop off at any other location.
- Please remain in your vehicle at Carline staff will escort campers to their camp location.
- Brightly-colored name dashboard placards are provided for easy identification at pick-up.

Lunch Procedures (12:00 p.m. - 12:50 p.m.)

- Lunch is NOT provided.
- Full-day campers may bring a lunch and eat in our Knowlton Campus Cafeteria.
- Campers enrolled in one half-day camp must be picked up and/or dropped off according to the daily schedule.

• Canterbury Student Volunteers and adult staff will supervise the campers during lunch.

Pick-Up Procedures (12:00 - 12:15 p.m. | 4:00 p.m. - 4:15 p.m.)

*After Care is <u>not</u> available; pick-up by 12:15 p.m. (morning) or 4:15 p.m. (afternoon camps)

- Enter through the entrance off 62nd Avenue NE (Knowlton Campus Camps)
- Adhere to one-way traffic signs and follow the traffic flow (see traffic map below)
- Please line up vehicles in the carline drop-off and pick-up zone
- Place name placard on the dashboard; names will be called by staff
- Staff will bring camper(s) to their vehicle.

What To Pack - Label personal items with the Camper's Name

- Reusable water bottle (filled)
- Snacks (Canterbury will not be providing snacks)
- Closed-toed shoes (campers should *not* wear flip-flops)
- Sunscreen (please apply sunscreen before drop-off each day)
- Change of clothing + hat (for outdoor activities)
- Lunch with an ice pack (if applicable)
- A positive attitude

What NOT to Pack

- Cell phones or other electronic devices -- unless requested by the camp instructor (campers have access to a school phone if needed).
- Personal toys or items that will be missed if lost
