The **Child Care Background Check (CCBC) Unit**, within the Michigan Department of Lifelong Education, Advancement, and Potential (MiLEAP), has launched a new **fully online process** for obtaining a **Central Registry clearance**. This clearance is required for **camp staff and unsupervised volunteers who are 21 years of age or older**.

The process is **simple**, **free**, **and quick**—most results are available within **5 business days**.

To get started:

- 1. Visit michigan.gov/ccbc-camps.
- 2. Create a new account.
- 3. Log in and submit a Central Registry clearance request.

Once your clearance is complete, you will have the option to:

- Download the letter,
- **Print** a copy; and/or
- **Share** it electronically using a secure link.

Please note: The camp is required to keep a copy of your Central Registry clearance on file, so be sure to provide your results using one of the above options.
