## CAMP KIDS ARE KIDS CHICAGO RULES

The following are of utmost importance. Please read each rule.

- 1. I understand that I may not discuss alternative medicine with any child at camp.
- 2. I understand and agree I will not bring tobacco, alcohol or illegal drugs to camp.
- 3. I agree not to press any particular health food or diet on any child at camp.
- 4. Any and all equipment I bring to camp is ENTIRELY MY PERSONAL RESPONSIBILITY and if necessary, I WILL ENSURE ADEQUATE INSURANCE COVERAGE for the loss or breakage which may occur at camp.
- 5. I understand that NO religious denomination may be promoted at camp.
- 6. I understand that I may not videotape or photograph anyone during the Virtual Camp sessions.
- 7. I understand that I may not bring any other guests to camp without specific permission from the Camp Director.
- 8. I understand I may not bring anyone under the age of 18 with me to camp as part of my group.
- 9. I understand that I must remain with the host/hostess I was assigned to.

I agree to indemnify and hold harmless Camp Kids Are Kids Chicago including officers and volunteers on staff against any claim by reason of accident, sickness, or otherwise resulting from participation in the camp.
