Driving Directions:

Cell phone reception is unreliable near camp, and GPS directions can send you on seasonal roads. We recommend using the detailed directions below for navigation within 5 miles of camp (from Hardwick North or Irasburg South).

Northbound

From Route 14, take a right turn at the "Craftsbury Outdoor Center 6 miles" sign (South Craftsbury Road). Pass through Craftsbury Village, go up a hill, through the village of Craftsbury Common (a collection of white houses at the top of the hill). Sterling College is on your left, the Post Office and Craftsbury Academy are on your right. Continue out of town approximately 3/4 mile past the Common, and look for a yellow curve sign. As the sign indicates, the pavement curves to the left, you want to bear right off the pavement and follow the "Craftsbury Outdoor Center" signs (staying on Mill Village Road). Continue on the dirt road for just under 1.25 miles and turn right onto Lost Nation Road. The entrance to the camp is approximately 1.8 miles after the turn. You will pass the Craftsbury Outdoor Center on the left and continue another mile until you come to an opening in the trees on the left with a Hosmer Point sign. Check-in is in at the top of the hill.

Southbound

From Route 14, look for a "Craftsbury Outdoor Center" sign on the right followed by a green "Craftsbury" state sign on the left. (North Craftsbury Road). Turn left and follow the pavement to the top of the hill about 1.4 miles. Look for a "Craftsbury Outdoor Center" sign and turn left onto the dirt road, immediately followed by a right onto Mill Village Road. Continue on the dirt road about 1.25 miles to Lost Nation Road (watch for the Craftsbury Outdoor Center sign) and turn right. The entrance to the camp is approximately 1.8 miles after

the turn. You will pass the Craftsbury Outdoor Center on the left and continue another mile until you come to an opening in the trees on the left with a Hosmer Point sign. Check-in is in at the top of the hill.

Local Attractions & Dining

Craftsbury General Store - Shop local products and essentials. Great cafe serving three meals a day. 5 miles from camp. Also in Craftsbury: gas at the Craftsbury Village Store, and the Art House gallery and gift shop.

Parker Pie - Local, family-friendly hot spot for pizza and beverages.

Highland Center for the Arts - Theater and art gallery with a great cafe, 14 miles from camp.

The Willy's Store - Famous general store has everything from hardware to clothing. Stop by the public beach for a swim while you're there.

Local breweries - Many award-winning breweries are located nearby, including Hill Farmstead Brewery in Greensboro, Lost Nation Brewing and Rockart Brewery in Morrisville, Kingdom Brewing in Newport, and The Alchemist Brewery in Stowe.

Bread and Puppet Theater - Unique giant puppet theater. Shows on Sundays or view the puppets at the self-serve museum.

The Museum of Everyday Life - A one-of-a-kind, self-serve museum in a barn, with a changing exhibit on the minutiae of everyday life.

The Old Stone House Museum - County historical center featuring exhibits on agriculture and local history. Great for those who'd like to learn more about the area.

Elmore State Park - Hike to the fire tower for great views.

Hike Mt. Pisgah - a strenuous hike with great views over famous Lake Willoughby. Swim in the lake and grab some ice cream before you go home.

Jay Peak Ski Resort - Waterpark, golf, and other resort amenities. Ride the tram to the top of Jay Peak and see all the way to Montreal.

Newport - Several great dining options, including burgers at the Cider House, thai or sushi at Dusit Thai, seafood at LaBelvidere, and italian at Lago Trattoria. Stop at the MAC Center for the Arts gallery next door.

Stowe - Shopping and dining with a walkable, quaint downtown.
