# Behavior Agreement for TLC Participants

# Twin Lakes Camp - Helping parents raise Godly children in a secular world.

# **General TLC Rules:**

- 1. Have FUN!
- 2. Listen to your leader.
- 3. The Golden Rule, treat others as you would want to be treated.
- 4. Don't die! Don't do anything that endangers yourself or others.

### As a TLC camper, I agree to...

#### Show respect to my fellow campers:

- 1. I will be kind with my actions. I will control my temper and not act violently toward others if upset. This includes my sibling(s), who may or may not be in my cabin.
- 2. I will be kind with my words. I will not use rude, profane, or insulting words to God or others. This includes my sibling(s), who may or may not be in my cabin.
- 3. I will be open to others. I will not show favoritism or exclude people from games or appropriate conversations.
- 4. I will only take or use property that belongs to me. I will not steal from others or TLC.
- 5. I will engage and participate in discussions and activities. I will not distract others and hinder their camp experience.

#### Show respect to TLC leaders:

- 1. I will be honest.
- 2. I will obey my Cabin Leader, LIT, and other TLC staff quickly and cheerfully.
- 3. I will obey the TLC dress code (found in Document Center on UltraCamp).

#### Show respect to the TLC environment:

- 1. I will do my part to keep the campgrounds and facilities clean. I will not destroy or damage camp property.
- 2. I will not purposely harm plants or animals.
- 3. I will not bring electronic devices to camp. (Devices will not be used if brought.)
- 4. I will not bring alcohol, non-prescription drugs, or tobacco products to camp.

# As a TLC camper's parent, I agree to...

- 1. Talk with my child about their behavior before coming to camp. I will work with my child to set behavior goals and follow up with them after the week at camp.
- 2. Provide TLC with adequate information about how to support your child with care best before they arrive at camp.
- 3. Be available to receive potential phone calls during the camp week to discuss behavioral issues or concerns that TLC staff may have. If an incident with my child occurs, I will support and work with the TLC staff to resolve the problem.
- 4. Be responsible for transporting my child home from camp early if my child's behavior results in them being sent home. I will ensure that my child has sought appropriate reconciliation with others to make restoration.
- 5. Provide feedback to TLC on issues I am aware of and give my suggestions for making things better in the future.

## As Twin Lakes Camp, we will strive to...

- 1. Provide safe and excellent Christ-centered programs and experiential learning opportunities that follow our mission and core values.
- 2. Support parents in their child-raising efforts and help when appropriate.
- 3. Address behavioral issues as quickly and thoroughly as possible. Depending on the offensive behavior's time span, frequency, and severity, TLC reserves the right to send a camper home immediately, at TLC's discretion, at the parent's expense, and without a refund. These

offenses include but are not limited to insensitive, abusive, harmful, and unsafe actions.

- Inappropriate sexual behavior: Touching the "swimsuit"-covering areas of another person's body, taking indecent photos of self or another person, exposing oneself to another person, or other forms of sexual harassment.
- Physical aggression: Hitting, shoving, kicking, fighting, or other aggressive contact or conduct towards another person.
- Aggressive language: Offensive and inappropriate terms directed towards another person or group.
- Bullying involves verbal, social, or physical behavior involving a power imbalance.
