

2026 Berkeley Albany Girl Scout Camp Details

Berkeley Albany GS Day Camp is a Volunteer Run Camp with Girl Scouts NorCal. We rent East Bay Regional Park Group Campsite(s) in Tilden Park in Berkeley California. The camp is traditionally held the second or third week of June each year. The schedule is determined by the last day of school in the Berkeley and Albany Unified School Districts and the availability of our Adult Volunteer Leaders. For the 2026 Season Berkeley Albany Girl Scout Day Camp will be from **June 15-19 at Buckeye and Orchard Picnic Areas** near Lake Anza on Brook Road off of Central Park Drive in Tilden Park.

The Camp serves children entering kindergarten through high school. We have scholarships available. All attendees must register as members of GSNorCal. You can register your child directly for our Camp Troop here:

Teens from eighth grade up are eligible to apply to be Councilors in Training (formerly "PA"s) at the camp. We welcome adult volunteers from the larger community. Parents, Grandparents, Neighbors and Friends are all most welcome. You may meet the best friend you never knew you had at our camp!

All staff, teenaged Councilors in Training and Adults, are required by GS NorCal to attend all in-person trainings/meetings, and complete online training as well. The initial training commitment is about 18 hours. Subsequent years the training is about ten hours, and includes visiting the site prior to the camp week.

Directions, Daily Attire and Supply lists, including requests for recycled and up-cycled items will be sent prior to the start of camp and repeated regularly through the camp week as daily reminders.
