Next week, we are going to do some activities involving improvisation action.

Special

This week we did a lot of unscrambling and matching for mix and match week! We placed animals in their correct habitats and had relay races games.

Next week we will roll around a beach ball with questions on it and go around answering them as a group to get to know more about each other. We will also be making stress balls out of balloons and flour as a fun craft experiment!



Science

This week in science the campers made playdoh and learned how to combine ingredients from the kitchen to create a reaction.

Next week we will learn what it takes to plant a seed with a patriotic twist!

Sports

We had another great week at camp! We started the week out learning skills in soccer and basketball, such as dribbling and passing. Later in the week we divided each group into two and played a game of soccer and basketball. We used trash cans for basketball hoops, and the children loved it! Everyone had an opportunity to kick the soccer ball into the goal and to shoot the basketball into the trash can.

Next week we will be playing Red, White, and Blue tag and have a Patriotic relay race in honor of it being the week of the 4th of July!

Drama

This week in tots drama we learned about Dr. Seuss! We made sock puppets and played a guessing game with the "Cat In The Hat" hat.

Next week is patriotic theme week, therefore I will incorporate a patriotic theme along with teaching about emotions!



Art

This week in art we learned all about mixing our primary colors and learned about the secondary colors. We butterflies out of coffee filters. We played with shaving cream and food coloring and made camp lanyards.

Next week for 4th of July week we will be making Uncle Sam masks and painting fireworks with toilet paper rolls. As well we will do a project with tie dye!

Tots Weekly Report

Science

This week, campers were introduced to the term "dissolve". Campers conducted an experiment involving sand, sugar, salt, and skittles to visually see the substances dissolving or not dissolving in water. A second experiment was also conducted this week and the campers had the opportunity to make slime!

Next week, campers will be introduced to the three states of matter: solid, liquid, and gas. An introduction experiment will be demonstrated so that campers can have a visual representation of the three states of matter involving balloons, air, water, and ice. The second experiment later in the week will have a fun, hands-on, 4th of July twist!

Special

This past week in the Tots Special class we worked on friendship. We made friendship flowers where the campers gave other campers compliments and we wrote it on the petals. We also read "We're All Wonders" and talked about how even though we don't all look the same and have differences we can all be friends. We made friendship bracelets later in the week.

Next week we're going to learn about the meaning of the 4th of July while making our own flags out of various materials. We're also making fake sparklers and learning about firework safety.



Music

This week in Tots music, the campers got creative and experimented with how items like glass jars and cans could be used as musical instruments. We also did an activity where we learned the song Tony Chestnut and did some other body identification songs.


Next week is Patriotic Week, and we will be learning about various patriotic and historical American music and composers. Then we will be a marching band along with the music. I'm looking forward to another great week!
