BROOKSIDE SPORTS

This week in Brookside Sports, the campers practiced their introductions and got to know each other through a number of fun games! BROOKSIDE STEM

This week in Brookside Science, the campers learned about the five senses through drawing and hands-on exploration. The campers also experimented with color mixing to discover how different hues are created. Next week, the campers will dive into the exciting world of matter as they explore solids, liquids, and gases through fun experiments like slime-making, magic milk, and more!





BROOKSIDE ART

This week in Brookside Art, the campers splattered into rainbow week with a burst of color and creativity! The campers created vibrant, Matisse-inspired oil pastel drawings and had a blast weaving colorful pom-poms after diving into a playful yarn exploration. TOTS STEM

This week in Tots STEM, our curious campers had a blast diving into the world of STEM through fun, hands-on activities! The campers kicked off the week by learning what STEM stands for and how science fits into it all. The campers then put their engineering skills to the test by building the tallest towers they could using blocks! The campers also explored biology by learning about life cycles, focusing on the fascinating stages of a butterfly's life-from egg to caterpillar to chrysalis to butterfly. Next week, the campers will build marshmallow towers, create their own caterpillars, and craft paper plate earths.

TOTS ART
